4 How many fewer minutes did he spend getting gas than driving?

Yolanda had 76 stickers.
She gave away 22 stickers.

5How many stickers does Yolanda have left?

An aquarium had 80 gallons of water.
Stanley drained out 37 gallons.
6 How many gallons are left?
Keith had 92 building blocks.
He gave 46 of them to Joey.
7 How many blocks does Keith have left?
