

### PROBATION

Probation is a court-ordered period of supervision for individuals who have been convicted of a crime. It is often used as an alternative to incarceration for first-time offenders or those with non-violent offenses. The probation officer monitors the individual's behavior, ensures compliance with court orders, and provides support and resources as needed. Violations of probation can result in a return to prison.
