GETTING STARTED

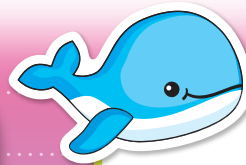
Decorate your diary cover and heart shaped lock with the pearls. For extra holding power, use the mini glue pen in case any of your decorations pop off.

LET'S PEEK INSIDE

Use the rainbow array of neon markers and your pom-pom pen to color-in, doodle and design your own diary pages. Don't forget to add your name to the inside cover page.

Pro Tip - To keep the ink from soaking through, use gentle pressure when writing or coloring.

Use the stickers to decorate your pages or to make your own sticker story.
