## Unit Projects Supply List

### Unit 1

- 2 to 2 ½ cups flour
- 1 cup salt
- Water
- Parchment or waxed paper
- Baking sheet and oven, optional
- White craft paint
- Paintbrush
- Black marker

### Unit 2

- 1 piece brown construction paper
- 1 piece blue construction paper
- 3 craft sticks
- White paper
- White glue
- Marker
- Blue crayon

### Unit 3

- Paper cups (approximately 2-inches across the bottom), black or any other color
- Ruler
- Scissors
- Black craft paint
- Paintbrush
- Black construction paper
- White glue or craft glue
- Embellishments as desired (examples: felt, buttons, ribbons, lace, craft feathers, brads, sequins, stickers, etc.)

### Unit 4

- 1 piece blue construction paper

- Scraps of other paper
- 6 tea bags
- White glue
- Brown paper
- Tape
- Glue stick

## Unit 5

- 3 pieces white cardstock
- Tape
- 1 piece of aluminum foil (a little larger than a piece of cardstock)
- Pencil
- Glue stick
- Ruler
- Marker
- White glue
- 22 craft sticks

## Unit 6

- 1  $\frac{3}{4}$  cups cornmeal
- 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  cups flour
- $\frac{1}{4}$  cup sugar
- 2 tablespoons baking powder
- $\frac{1}{2}$  teaspoon salt
- 2  $\frac{1}{4}$  cups milk
- 1 tablespoon vinegar
- 2 eggs, well beaten
- $\frac{1}{4}$  cup oil, plus oil for skillet
- Butter and honey or maple syrup for serving

## Unit 7

- Notebook or journal
- Writing and drawing utensils

## Unit 8

- 1 piece white poster board
- 1 ruler/yardstick
- Pencil
- 1 sponge
- White paper
- Cardstock
- Pen
- Scissors
- Craft paint: red, blue, gold
- 2 small paper plates

## Unit 9

- 1 paper cup
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Craft sticks
- White glue
- Raffia, yarn, or narrow string (raffia is long strands of dried grass, available at craft stores)

## Unit 10

- White or colored paper
- Ruler
- Colored pencils, crayons, or markers
- Stapler

## Unit 11

- construction paper in these colors: blue, brown, black, gray, yellow or gold
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Glue stick
- Small shoes to trace

## Unit 12

- construction paper: 1 red, 1 brown, 1 black, 2 white
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Ruler
- Pen
- Colored pencils

## Unit 13

- 40 craft sticks
- Black marker
- black construction paper
- ruler
- 4 pennies
- 4 sheets blue construction paper
- Crayons, colored pencils, or markers
- 2 dice

## Unit 14

- Food-safe paper (waxed paper or parchment paper) cut in 9-inch squares
- ½ cup cornmeal
- ½ cup water
- 1 ½ cups additional water
- ¼ teaspoon salt
- ⅓ cup dried fruit (such as cranberries or raisins, or whortleberries, if you have them!)
- 2 to 3 tablespoons molasses (or ¼ cup sorghum, honey, or maple syrup)
- Graham crackers

## Unit 15

- White adult sock
- 2 clothespins
- Craft or fabric glue
- Cardboard circle, 1¼ inch
- Markers: black, brown
- White paper
- Pen
- Scissors
- Scraps of felt: red, black, brown
- 2 google eyes (or eyes made from two tiny circles of black paper glued to two small circles of white paper)
- Small envelope
- Old letter with postage stamp

## Unit 16

- 1 sheet white paper
- black pen
- green crayon
- scissors
- glue stick
- 1 sheet white cardstock
- 2-inch clear mailing tape
- hole punch
- thin ribbon (red, orange, and/or yellow)

## Unit 17

- 1 piece white posterboard
- black marker
- 5 pieces white cardstock
- 1 piece white paper
- pencil
- scissors
- brown construction paper
- glue stick
- household items (see page 364)

## Unit 18

- scripts
- costumes

## Unit 19

- material for medal (thin white cardboard or cardstock in white, yellow, or gold)
- circle to trace (about 3 to 3 ½ inches across)
- pencil
- yellow crayon (if needed)
- black pen or marker
- scissors
- material for band (yarn, ribbon, construction paper for paper chain)
- stapler or tape

## Unit 20

- 5 sheets of construction paper or cardstock, any color
- circle to trace
- pencil
- black marker
- scissors
- tape
- stick
- pebbles, acorns, or twigs

## Unit 21

- construction paper (red, green, purple, yellow, orange)
- pencil
- scissors
- “tow sacks” (any kind of cloth bags)

## Unit 22

- Oil for greasing pan
- 1 cup all-purpose flour (or glutenfree all-purpose substitute)
- 3/4 cup white sugar
- 2 tablespoons cocoa powder
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 cup milk (or water)
- 2 tablespoons oil
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 3/4 cup packed brown sugar
- 1/4 cup cocoa powder
- 1 1/2 cups water

- card
- gift
- box
- tissue paper
- ribbon

## Unit 24

- 1 piece white posterboard
- pencil
- thick black marker
- fine black marker or pen
- red and blue crayons

## Unit 25

- 1 paper plate
- gray crayon
- 2 sheets white cardstock

- pencil
- scissors
- colored pencils (red, blue)
- toothpick
- glue stick
- tape
- white paper
- aluminum foil
- hole punch
- yarn, thread, or string
