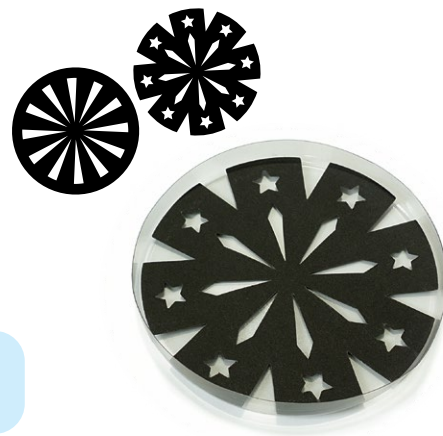


## Assemble Your Light

**1** Screw the jar onto the light up lid. **Note:** Once the light is assembled, the bottom of the jar will actually be the top of your light.

**2** Place one of the shadow disks inside the clear cap as shown then onto your light jar.

**Helpful Tip:** You can swap out shadow disks by gently sliding the diamond painting wrap off first.



## Time to Display

**3** Carefully form your diamond painting into a cylinder inserting both tabs into their slots to secure.



**4** Slide your diamond painting over the shadow disk cap and onto the jar.

**5** Find a USB power adapter and the best place near an outlet to display your light. Be sure to ask an adult first.

**6** Press the toggle switch attached to the USB cable to turn your light on and off.



Handle with care and save any materials for touch up and repairs.

## Before you Begin

Clear your space so you have plenty of room to work. Spread out your colorful gem bags, gem tray, stylus and wax square.

### Helpful Tips:

- Cover your work surface with a large towel. This will help contain the gems in case they spill.
- Use a large resealable bag for storing your components.

**Safety First!** As with any electrical appliance, please seek adult permission and assistance before operating the light. You will need to insert your USB cable into a USB port or plug adapter (not included).



## Prep your Gems

Find the sealed ends of each gem bag. Carefully peel it open, pour some gems into your tray then reseal the bag. Leave room in your tray. This will make it easier to pick up the gems with your stylus.

**Helpful Tip:** Upside down gems can be flipped over by shaking the tray side to side, or use your fingers.






# Let's Diamond Paint

## Helpful Tips:

- Peel a little of the protective cover at a time as you work. If you need to stop at any point, you can cover your design then come back to it later.

- If you'd like help with gem placement, line up your artwork wrap with the guide. Temporarily secure it in place by attaching a small piece of sticky putty → 

- You can either match your gems with the printed colors or diamond paint your way.

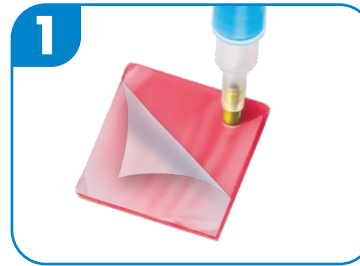
- If you run out of your favorite color have fun blending gem colors for a cool effect.

## Important:

When finished, press firmly down on all of the gems so they stay in place. Then remove the sticky putty from the back of your diamond painting.



This color pattern → matches the light on the front of the packaging.



Peel the clear film off the wax then press & twist the tip of the stylus into the wax to fill it.



Peel off the clear protective cover to reveal the adhesive.



Pick up gems with the tip of the wax filled stylus. *(When it stops working, refill it with more wax.)*



Place the gems on the sticky adhesive.
