

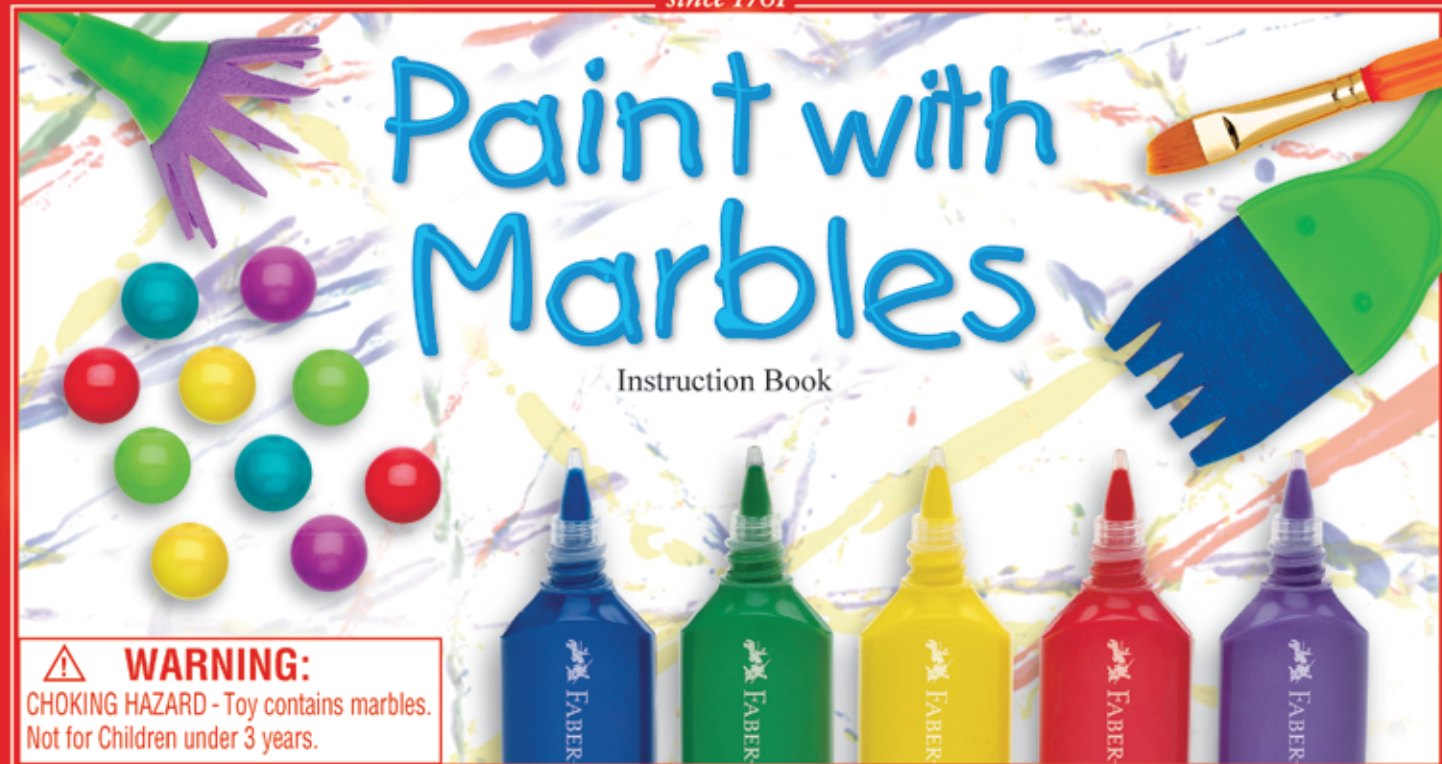

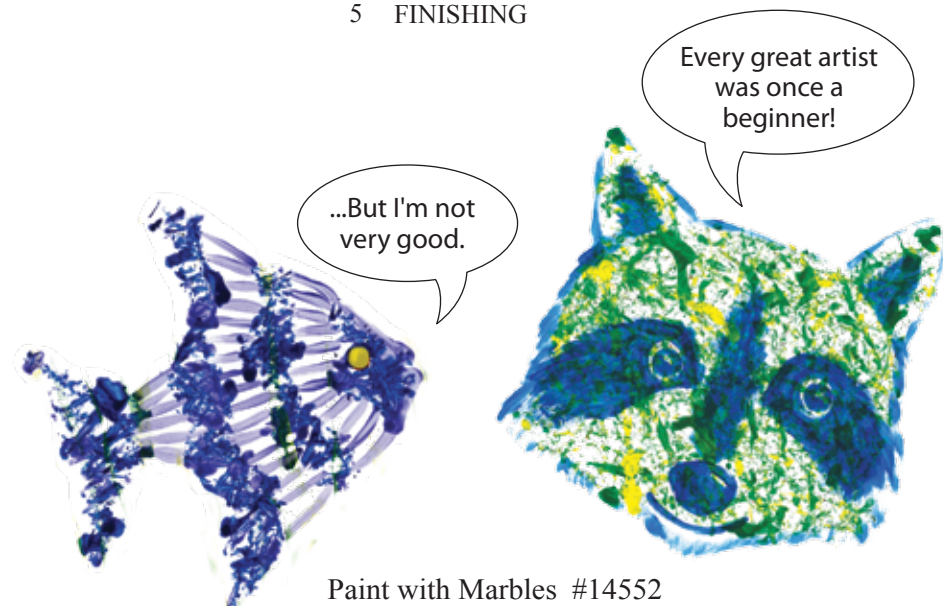

Time to Prep

Important Information about this Paint

The paint included is a specially formulated non-toxic paint. Although the paint is washable from skin with soap and water, it may stain some surfaces. Cover your work surface with newspaper. Wear old clothes or a paint smock. Have a cup of water and paper towels handy and clean up any spills immediately while the paint is still wet. For best results, wash your marbles and brushes with water after each use.



You will be using the top tray as your marble painting tray. The rest of the packaging can be used to store your art components.

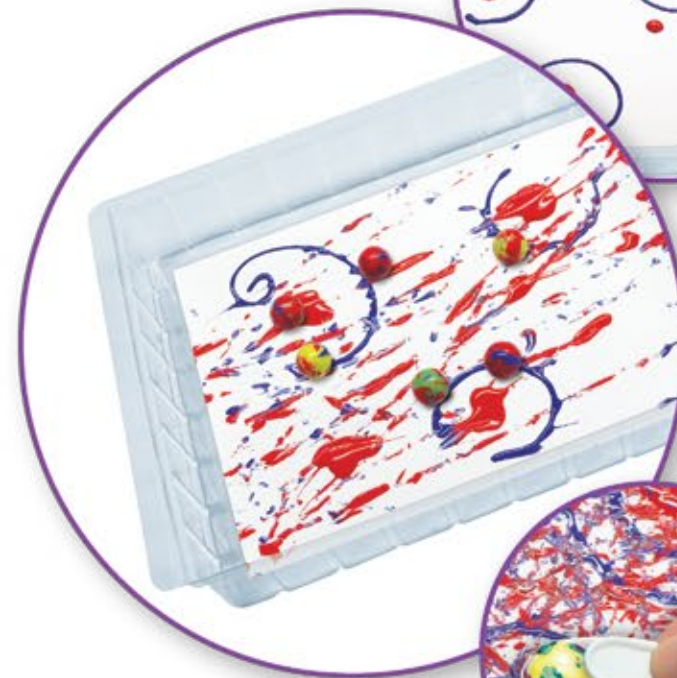

Let's Paint

1. Place a piece of paper in the marble painting tray.
2. Add drops and/or swirls of paint onto your paper.
3. Drop your marbles into the tray.
4. Tilt the tray side to side and back and forth until the marbles roll through the paint. Keep moving the marbles around until you're happy with your art.
5. To keep your fingers clean, remove the marbles with a marble scoop.
6. Use the brushes to add more texture and designs to your piece.

CAUTION: As you move and tilt the tray, be sure to keep the marbles contained inside.

Stencils

The stencils are used to block out paint from areas of your paper. To use the stencils, follow the instructions below.

1. Place a piece of paper in the marble painting tray.
2. Place a stencil on top of the paper.
3. Squeeze some paint into the open stencil areas.
4. Follow steps 3-6 on page 3.
5. You can use your broad tip paint brush to add more definition to your design.



Finishing

When your art is completely dry, place a sticky square on each corner of the back of your paper.

Hold the paper over a piece of the foam until it looks centered and press it down firmly.

Flip the foam over. Place a plastic hanger in the top center of the foam so it hangs straight.



Clean-up

Be sure to clean off your marbles, spoons, brushes and tray before putting everything away.

Enjoy this unique and fun way to create abstract art!
