Sensory Bin

For more than 50 years, children and their families have enjoyed reading "The Very Hungry Caterpillar." Now you can enjoy a fun sensory experience, inspired by this beloved children's classic.



CARE AND SAFETY

- Children should be supervised during play not suitable for children under 3.
- Prepare the area under the bin with a towel or table cover to collect any spills.
- · Children should wash their hands before use.
- Sensory sand should be kept away from the eyes, nose and mouth.

 If contact should occur, rinse the area with water.
- Water and humidity will change the consistency of your sensory sand add a bit of water or air dry as needed to return it to its original texture
- Keep the sensory bin closed when not in use.



Children will need assistance for this step.



First, decorate the sides of the bin with the clings.

Note: If you are having difficulty rearranging the clings, wipe the clings and bin with a damp cloth to remove the sand residue.

Have an adult fill the bin with sensory sand. Spread the sand out evenly and arrange the items in the bin.



Scoop, stamp, and play while engaging your senses. Have fun walking your caterpillar through the sensory bin while you act out the story of "The Very Hungry Caterpillar."



TRY THIS

- · Count the items inside the bin.
- · Identify each fruit and color.
- · Make up your own story.
- Memory game: Parents hide some objects under the sensory sand. Have your child guess what is missing.
