

PROBATION

Probation is a court-ordered period of supervision for individuals who have been convicted of a crime. It is often used as an alternative to incarceration for first-time offenders or those with minor offenses. Probation officers monitor the individual's behavior and ensure they comply with the terms of their sentence, such as attending counseling, maintaining employment, and staying out of trouble with the law. Failure to comply can result in the individual being sent to prison.
