


#### **IMPORTANT**

Do not use power tools above 8 volts to assemble.

## Assembly Instructions 2/10


#### **IMPORTANT**

- Use a soft cloth between these parts and the floor.
- Do not use power tools above 8 volts to assemble.
- Do not tighten all the bolts until each part is properly assembled.
- The unit must be level to work properly. Use the included adjustable levelers to level.
- Keep Hex Wrench as the bolts may need to be tightened in the future.

#### STEP 1

Insert Cam Lock Screws into pre-drilled holes in Plinths (D), (E), Black Panels (F), (G) and Front Panel (H), then tighten. (See Figure 1)


Orientate Magnets so Arrow labels on back of Magnets point in same direction as Arrow labels on Back Panels (F) and (G), then attach Magnets to Back Panels (F) and (G) with Wood Screws for Magnet into pre-drilled holes. (See Figure 2)



## Assembly Instructions 3/10

#### STEP 2

Orientate Base (C) so Arrow labels on Base (C) point to Plinths (D) and (E), then attach Plinths (D) and (E) to Base (C) with Cam Locks. (See Figure 3)



Arrow labels point to Plinths (D) and (E)




#### STEP 3


Attach Back Panel (F) to Back Panel (G).

## STEP 4


Attach unit from Step 2 to unit from Step 3 with Cam Locks.

Attach Rails (I) to unit with Cam Locks.


Attach Front Panel (H) to unit with Cam Locks.






Cam Lock Screw -

### **STEP 11**

Insert Cam Lock Screws into pre-drilled holes in Supports (S), then tighten.








**STEP 12** 


Attach Supports (S) to Support (R) with Cam Locks.

## STEP 13

Attach unit form Step 12 to unit from Step 10.



## Assembly Instructions 8/10



#### **STEP 14**

Turn unit from Step 4 to its upright position.

Insert Cam Lock Screws into pre-drilled holes in unit from Step 4, then tighten.

Attach unit form Step 4 to unit from Step 13 with Cam Locks and Head Cap Bolts (short).

#### STEP 15

Insert Adjustable Pins into front panel and back panels at desired level.


Place Shelves (X) into position.

Attach Doors (T) and (U) to unit by sliding door hinges into front panel hinges. (See Figure 5)

Attach Top (A) to unit with Head Cap Bolts.






#### Drawer (Z)





#### **STEP 16**


Attach Drawer Front (Z1) and Drawer Back (Z2) to Drawer Side (Z3) with Wood Screws (long).


Attach Drawer Side (Z4) to unit with Wood Screws (long).

#### **STEP 17**

Slide Drawer Bottom (Z5) into groove.


Attach Drawer Bottom (Z5) to unit with Wood Screws (short).






#### **STEP 18**

Attach Handle with Machine Screws.



## Assembly Instructions 10/10



#### **STEP 19**

Insert Adjustable Pins into side panels at desired level.


Place Shelves (Y) into position.

Attach Doors (V) and (W) to unit by sliding door hinges into side panel hinges.

Attach Handles to Doors (V) and (W) with Machine Screws. (See Figure 6)

Slide Drawers (Z) into position.

Level unit by adjusting the adjustable levelers on bottom of unit. (See Figure 7)





# CARE INSTRUCTIONS

## **NEVER**

allow liquids to remain on furniture. Absorption causes parts to warp and split and finishes to delaminate.

# **NEVER**

use glass cleaners on finished furniture. Ammonia chemically attacks the finish.
