

BLUETOOTH OPERATION



PAIRING & DISCOVERING A NEW BLUETOOTH CONNECTION

1) Power on the *ATV85B* by pressing and holding down the *Play/Pause* multifunction

button for 3 seconds, the blue LEDs will start to flash, signalling that the ATV85B is now ready for Bluetooth pairing.

NOTE: You have 30 seconds before you must restart this procedure over again.

2) Now that the ATV85B is in pairing mode:

ANDROID users:

- a. Go into the Settings Menu of your device
- b. Enter the Bluetooth Menu
- c. TURN ON Bluetooth and press SCAN
- d. "BOSS ATV85B" will now be displayed under AVAILABLE DEVICES e. Press "BOSS ATV85B" to get Bluetooth connected

iOS users:

- a. Go into the Settings Menu of your iOS device
- b. Enter the Bluetooth Menu c. TURN ON Bluetooth
- d. "BOSS ATV85B" will now be displayed

e. Press "BOSS ATV85B" to get Bluetooth connected

3) If the BOSS ATV85B is not seen, repeat the above steps to refresh the "Device List"

4) When the connection is successful, you are now ready to stream music from your favorite

BEFORE INSTALLING THIS PRODUCT




To avoid potential shorts in the electrical system, be sure to disconnect the (-) battery cable before installation. Use this unit with a 12-Volt battery and negative grounding only. Failure to do so may result in a fire or malfunction.




When replacing the fuse, be sure to only use a fuse of the rating specified on this product. To avoid short-circuiting, cover any disconnected leads with insulating tape. It is especially important to insulate any unused wires, which if left uncovered may cause a short circuit. When connecting other devices to this product, refer to the manual for the product to be connected. The black cable is ground, make sure to connect the ground wire first. Ensure that the ground wire is properly connected to metal parts of the vehicles body frame or direct to the battery if your vehicle does not have a grounded chassis frame The ground wire of this units power amp and a second powered system must be connected to the frame separately with different screws. If the screw for the ground wire loosens or falls out, it could result in fire or malfunction.

SPEAKER MOUNTING SUGGESTIONS



CAUTION!! Mounting straps should be double checked to be sure they are tight and secure before each use of the vehicle. The carry pouch is designed to keep your device safe from debris, make sure to close the pouch cover securely before using vehicle.



RECONNECTION

device:

1) Power on the ATV85B and your last paired device Bluetooth.

2) The unit will now automatically reconnect


3) If your device was previously paired with the ATV85B, but it wasn't the last paired

- a. Ensure no other devices are currently paired
- b. Enter the Bluetooth Menu on your device being paired
- c. "BOSS ATV85B" will display under AVAILABLE DEVICES d. Choose the "BOSS ATV85B" to reconnect
- 4) If the device is out of range from the ATV85B, it will disconnect automatically:
 - a. To reconnect once device is back in range, press the Play/Pause
 - b. The ATV85B will now reconnect to the device

To avoid battery exhaustion, be sure to occasionally run the Tips: vehicles engine while using this product.

Using this product without running the engine can drain the battery


the positive battery terminal ■ The ground cable length should not exceed 18 inches (See wiring diagram)

STREAMING MUSIC



MULTIFUNCTION CONTROLLER BLUETOOTH OPERATION

1) Press the PLAY/PAUSE once to start playing music or press the PLAY button from vour device touch screen


2) To skip songs or advance, press the NEXT TRACK button 3) To select the previous song, press the ($||\langle|$) **PREVIOUS TRACK** button

VOLUME CONTROL

4) To raise the volume, *Press and Hold* the VOL + button 2 ~ 3 seconds 5) To lower the volume, **Press and Hold** the (||||) **VOL** - button 2 ~ 3 seconds

Tips: Make sure your device Bluetooth volume is set at 75% level before stowing in to the carry pouch



GETTING STARTED GETTING TO KNOW YOUR ATV85B MULTIFUNCTION CONTROLLER (MFC)

MFC - MULTIFUNCTION CONTROLLER

- BLUETOOTH INDICATOR LED(BLUE) / AUX-IN STATUS INDICATOR(RED)
- 3.5mm AUX-INPUT
- PLAY/PAUSE / Press and hold for POWER ON
- PREVIOUS TRACK / Press and hold for VOL -NEXT TRACK / Press and hold for VOL + /
- Warning tone while up to maximum volume
- Disconnect any paired Bluetooth device by pressing button for 4 seconds
- Clear any paired Bluetooth device in memory by pressing 🚷 button
- Disconnect any paired Bluetooth device by turning off bluetooth in your device setting menu
- When power on, blue back lit \(\begin{align*} \text{button sparkles slowly for 30+ seconds} \)
 to search for ex-paired device; after then \(\beta \) button blue back lit turns to sparkle quickly for 9mins 30secs until it is powered off
- When Bluetooth devie is out of connection range and Bluetooth pairing is disconnected automatically, and then blue back lit 3 button sparkles slowly for 1 min to look for ex-paired device, after then 3 button blue back
- lit turns to sparkle quickly for 9mins until it is powered off 12 When operation voltage is lower than 9.5Volt, MFC gives warning tone
- 13 MFC concludes tones of definition : Power On/Off , Bluetooth connection / Disconnection , Maximum volume, Lower voltage



MULTIFUNCTION CONTROLLER AUX-IN OPERATION

1) Power on the *ATV85B* by pressing and holding down the PLAY/PAUSE

2) Disconnect any paired Bluetooth device by turning off Bluetooth in your devices

3) Connect the integrated 3.5mm AUX-IN cable located on right side of the MFC to your devices headphone jack

VOLUME CONTROL

4) To raise the volume, *Press and Hold* the VD *VOL* + button 2 ~ 3 seconds

5) To lower the volume, **Press and Hold** the (VOL - button 2 ~ 3 seconds

Tips: Make sure your device headphone volume is set at 75% level before stowing in to the carry pouch
