GETTING STARTED

Start with clean hands and a clean work surface.
For crafting ideas, refer to the pictures on the box.



DECORATE

Decide where you want to place the stickers. Smooth out the bag, then peel and press firmly into place. Continue decorating the back of the tote. For best results, keep the stickers away from the edge of your tote bag.



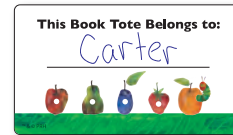
Once your stickers are pressed in place, they will be difficult to reposition. If you do need to move them, you may need to use a little craft glue to hold them in place.



PERSONALIZE

You can personalize the printed card with your name. Younger children may need help with this step.

Slide card into the back of The Very Hungry Caterpillar apple. Use the strap to attach it to the book tote handle as shown.
