SCHEDULE 1 (1997)

## 1.0 INTRODUCTION

1.1 This schedule sets out the minimum standards for the design, construction, installation, testing and commissioning of water supply systems for buildings.

## 2.0 SCOPE

- 2.1 This schedule applies to all buildings, including residential, commercial, industrial and public buildings.
- 2.2 It covers the design, construction, installation, testing and commissioning of the water supply system from the point of entry to the building to the point of use.
- 2.3 It includes the design, construction, installation, testing and commissioning of the water supply system for the following purposes:
  - 2.3.1 Drinking water
  - 2.3.2 Domestic hot water
  - 2.3.3 Heating
  - 2.3.4 Cooling
  - 2.3.5 Industrial processes
  - 2.3.6 Fire protection
- 2.4 It does not cover the design, construction, installation, testing and commissioning of the water supply system for the following purposes:
  - 2.4.1 Irrigation
  - 2.4.2 Industrial processes (other than those listed in 2.3.5)
  - 2.4.3 Fire protection (other than those listed in 2.3.6)
