Congratulations on your purchase of our Bariatric Trapeze Bar with Stand! Our trapeze bar is engineered and designed with durability and easy maintenance in mind.


The trapeze bar will allow patients to lift themselves while in bed.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

Do not operate your Bariatric Trapeze Bar with Stand until you read and fully understand this manual.


- Do not operate your trapeze bar until it is fully assembled and checked.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity (1000 lb.) of the Bariatric Trapeze Bar with Stand.
- Do not modify or replace with parts other than those manufactured by Dynarex.



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

- A. Please carefully unpack the container and remove the Bariatric Trapeze Bar with Stand from the shipping carton.
- B. Inspect the packaging, and make sure that there are no shipping damages and all the components are in the shipping carton.
 - 2 Floor Bases
 - 1 Triangle Frame
 - 1 Upright Frame
 - 1 Trapeze Grab Bar (with chain)
 - 3 Complete Screw-Washer-Nut-Bolt sets

C. Assistance is needed and highly recommended in completing the final assembly due to heavy weight of parts.



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Insert Triangle Frame to the Floor Base (see figures 1 and 2).



2. Insert screw, ensuring it goes through all four holes and is extended through the opening. Add the washer (figure 3) and tighten the nut (figure 4).

3. Repeat step 1 to 2 for the other floor base.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

4. Insert Upright Frame to the top of the Triangle Base (figure 5).



5. Insert screw, ensuring it goes through all four holes and is extended through the opening. Add the washer and tighten the nut.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

6. Slide trapeze holder ring over the tube. Insert thumb screw through ring and turn clockwise until tight to secure in place (figure 6).

MAINTENANCE

- 1. Clean the Bariatric Trapeze Bar with Stand regularly with non-abrasive cleaners.
- 2. Check monthly that all screws are tight and have not loosened.
- 3. Make sure all rubber tips and ends are in good condition for use.
