I. Product Description

CRC Fuel Injector Cleaner removes deposits from injector pintles to allow for better flow and more efficient operation. It cleans carburetors, intake systems, valves, ports and fuel lines, disperses water and improves fuel atomisation. It can reduce knocks caused by deposits and reduces engines' demands for higher octane fuel. It is safe for use with leaded and unleaded fuel and will not harm catalytic converters or oxygen sensors.

II. Application and Directions

1. Add entire contents of one 350ml bottle to fuel tank (treats 45 litres) and fill with fuel.
2. Use regularly to maintain engine cleanliness.
3. For existing deposit problems, initially use 2 containers per 45 litres of fuel.

VI. *Special Precautions*

General:

Flammable liquid and vapour. Keep away from heat, sparks, open flames, hot surfaces. No smoking. Keep container tightly closed. Avoid breathing dust, fume, gas, mist, vapours, spray. Use only outdoors or in a well-ventilated area. Store in a well-ventilated area. Keep container tightly closed. Dispose of empty containers safely. All unused product should be disposed of in conformance with local and HSNO regulations, do not contaminate water supply.

First Aid:

Swallowed – Do not induce vomiting. Give water to rinse out mouth, then provide liquid slowly and as much as casualty can comfortably drink. Seek medical advice. Avoid giving milk or oils. Avoid giving alcohol.

Skin – Immediately remove all contaminated clothing, including footwear. Flush skin and hair with running water (and soap if available). Seek medical attention in event of irritation.

Eyes – Wash out immediately with fresh running water. Ensure complete irrigation of the eye by keeping eyelids apart and away from eye and moving the eyelids by occasionally lifting the upper and lower lids. Seek medical attention without delay; if pain persists or recurs seek medical attention.

Inhalation – Remove from contaminated area. Lay patient down. Keep warm and rested.
