

## 2019 OREGON SYRAH

In 1999, we began sourcing fruit with an eye to making a unique Oregon Syrah. Over the years, we slowly developed our signature Penner-Ash Syrah style, a balance between structure and sweetness from the warmer southern Oregon vineyards, and blue fruit notes, nice acidity, and freshness from Hood River sourcing.

### 2019 VINTAGE

The 2019 growing season started cool with small amounts of rain followed by warmer than average summer temperatures. As harvest approached, cooler fall temperatures allowed us to capture ripeness and flavor intensity in the grapes.

### TASTING NOTES

Aromas of chocolate covered cherries, tobacco, and spiced oak. Blueberry sweetness is peppered with fine grain tannin creating dense layers and a savory finish.
