


Mystery Animal

An activity for 2 people




Materials

Get Ready

- Good readers **ask and answer questions** about what they read.
- Some questions begin with **who, what, where, when, and why**.

Play

1. Read *At the Pet Store*.
2. Pull 1 Letter Rod from the bag.
3. What animal name from the passage begins with that letter? Ask your partner a question about this animal. Use the Five Ws Cards to help.
4. Take turns pulling out letters and asking questions until the Mystery Bag is empty.

Ask your partner a question about a story your teacher read to the class.







Get Ready

3. Turn over a card. Ask a question about the story, starting with the word on the card.
4. Take turns until each person has asked and answered 4 questions.





Spin-a-Question



Get Ready

- Good readers **ask and answer questions** about what they read.

Play

1. Read *At the Pet Store*.
2. Spin the spinner. Move your chip that number of spaces on the board.
3. Ask a question about the story that begins with the word you land on.
4. Take turns spinning, asking questions, and answering them until all players have reached *Finish*.

James and his mom saw a cat.


