Installation Steps:

- Step 1. Locate where you would like to install the towel bar by measuring from end to end on the towel bar then measure the desired height on the wall where the towel bar will hang (fig 1).
- Step 2. Position the mounting template on the desire location, and use a level to make sure it is level.
- Step 3. Use a pencil to mark both bracket holes. Repeat this step for the other side.
- Step 4. Remove the template from wall and use a 1/4" drill bit to pre-drill holes in the drywall where pencil marks are drawn (fig 2).
- Step 5. Hammer in the drywall anchors until flush with the wall (fig 3).
- Step 6. Secure the mounting brackets (with the rib facing down) to the wall using the provided screws (fig 4).
- Step 7. Insert the unit with holes facing down to the bracket and tighten setscrews with an Allen wrench until the base is tight and secure (fig 5).

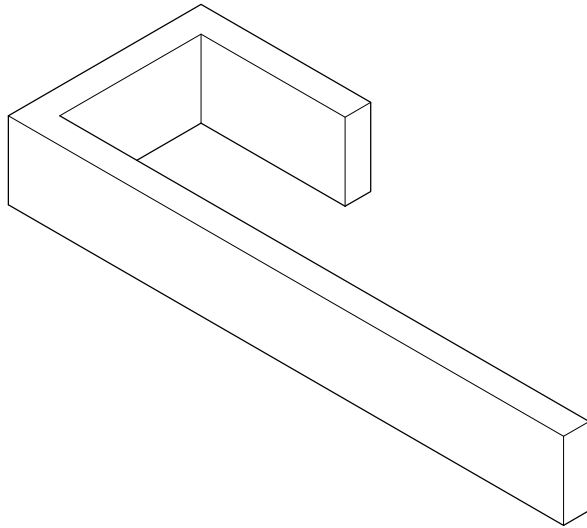
Cleaning

Installation Steps:

- Step 2. Place a base onto the wall and trace around it with a pencil (fig 1).
- Step 3. Place the mounting bracket (with the rib facing down) in the center of the pencil outline you just made and mark the location of the mounting screws (fig 2).
- Step 4. Remove the mounting bracket from wall and use a 1/4" drill bit to pre-drill holes in the drywall where pencil marks are drawn (fig 3).
- Step 5. Hammer in the drywall anchors until flush with the wall (fig 4).
- Step 6. Secure the mounting brackets (with the rib facing down) to the wall using the provided screws (fig 5).
- Step 7. Insert the unit with holes facing down to the bracket and tighten setscrews with an Allen wrench until the base is tight and secure (fig 6).

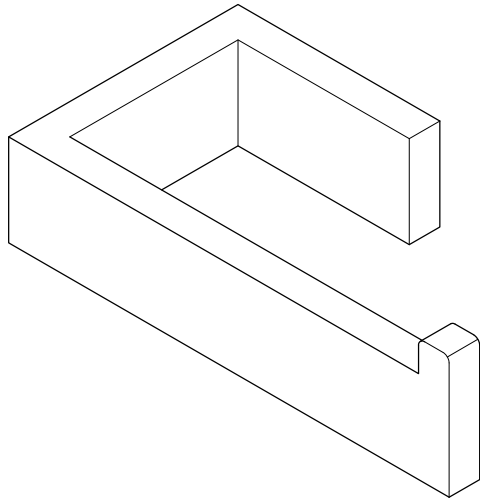




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Toilet Paper Holder Installation

Installation Steps:

- Step 1. Locate where you would like to install the toilet paper holder.
Place a base onto the wall and trace around it with a pencil (fig 1).
- Step 2. Unscrew the set screw of the base and remove the mounting bracket.
- Step 3. Place the mounting bracket (with the rib facing down) in the center of the pencil outline you just made and mark the location of the mounting screws (fig 2).
Drill holes at the marked locations (fig 3).
- Step 4. Insert anchors into the holes with a hammer until flush with the wall (fig 4).
- Step 5. Screw the mounting bracket (with the rib facing down) to the wall with the mounting screws (fig 5).
- Step 6. Insert the unit, with the small hole in the base underneath, over the mounting bracket by tightening the set screws with an Allen wrench until the base is tightly fixed (fig 6).

Cleaning

Clean with a damp cloth only.
Avoid using metal or abrasive polishes.
