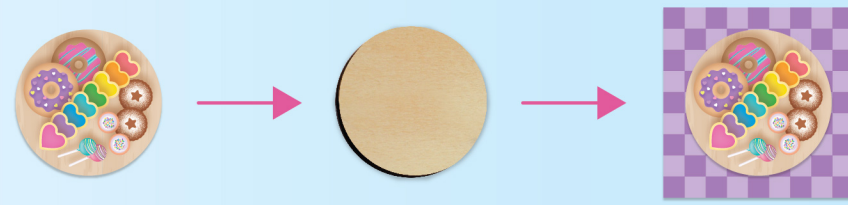


Sweets Charcuterie Board

Attach sticker to the circle and place it on the picnic blanket for your animals to enjoy!



Hopscotch Bridge

Fold both sides under at the score lines.



Place adhesive dots on each corner and arch over stream. Press down to secure.



More Fun!

Knot more blue string to the cloud bases and attach the raindrop stickers to make more magical rain!



Add your animal friends and the rest of the stickers around your Magical Land. They can have fun smelling the flowers and visiting with the fairies!



Place Your Chia

When your Magical Land is complete, wrap the green cardstock strips around the plastic tray and slide the slots together. Carefully add the chia trays in front of the castle and rainbow. In most cases the seeds should begin to sprout in about 3-5 days. For best results, keep your Magical Land in a warm sunny place. Use your dropper to water daily.



Handle with care and save any leftover materials for touch up and repairs.

You can purchase more chia seeds at your local grocery and garden stores or online.

Paper towels can be used as grow mats. Just fold them a few times and cut to size as needed.

Note: If you notice new fuzzy growth, it's most likely tiny roots. Sometimes excess humidity causes mold to grow. Better air circulation helps. This type of mold is nature's way of breaking down plant material to create new soil and is not harmful to your health.

Important Information About the Paint

- Paint is permanent when dry and may stain clothing, fabric and other surfaces. Cover your work surface and wear a smock or old clothes.
- Clean up spills immediately. Wash clothing within an hour to help prevent stains.
- Have a cup of water and paper towels handy.
- Rinse your paint brush with water before changing colors and after use.



Prep Your Grow Trays

1. Use your dropper to add water to the trays. Fill each one about halfway.
2. Fold the corners of the grow mats under and gently press them into the trays. Allow them to soak up the water for at least 15 minutes. While you wait, start painting your Magical Land.
3. Once your grow mats have absorbed the water they should look wet – add more water if they don't. **Sprinkle a few seeds** around each mat. Save the rest to replant later. Set the trays aside until your Magical Land is ready.

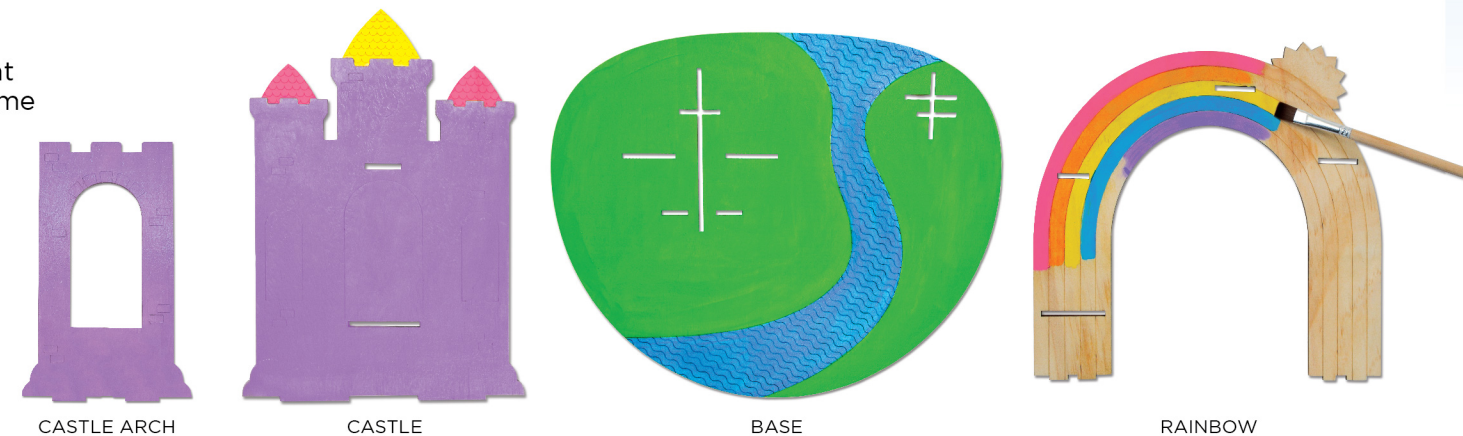
Important: If you plant too many seeds they will not sprout.



Let's Paint

Begin painting the engraved side first. This is the front of your Magical Land. For painting the other wood pieces, refer to the rest of the instructions.

After the paint is dry, add some sparkle with glitter gel!

Stickers and Cardstock

Once the paint and glitter gel is fully dry, add detail by applying stickers and cardstock pieces.

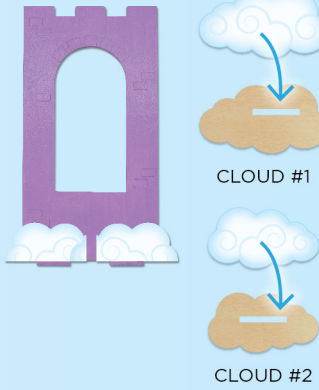
1 Apply the doorway and 3 window stickers to the castle



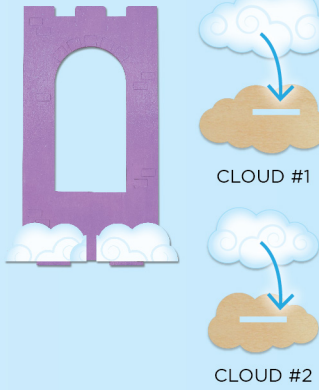
2 Attach the 3 cardstock flags behind the castle, and 2 cardstock clouds in front of the castle with adhesive dots



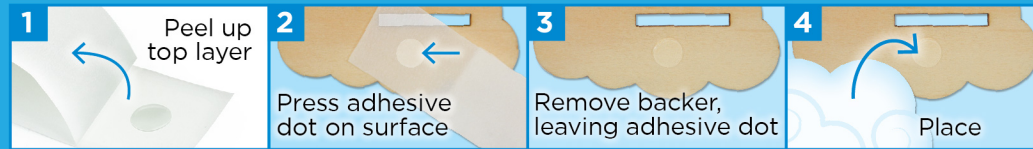
3 Attach the 2 cardstock clouds to the front of the castle arch



4 Attach cardstock cloud #1 and #2 to their bases



Pro Tip: Re-positionable adhesive dots will hold your cardstock pieces in place as shown.

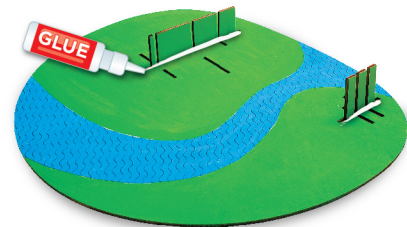
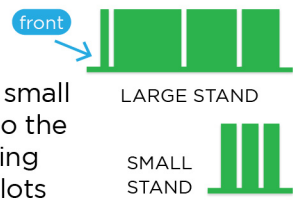


Time to Build

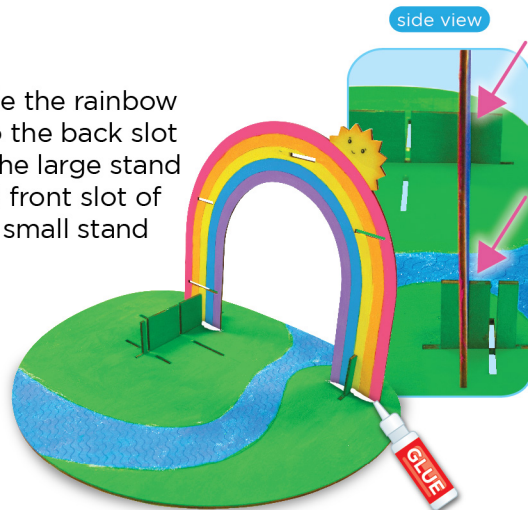
Rainbow and Castle

Start with the engraved side of pieces facing up. Apply a small line of glue where the pieces meet. Once dry, the glue will help hold the them in place.

1 Slide the large and small stands into the base making sure the slots line up



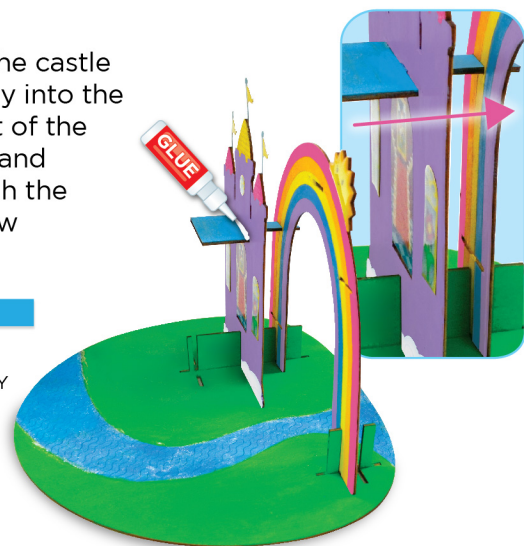
2 Slide the rainbow into the back slot of the large stand and front slot of the small stand



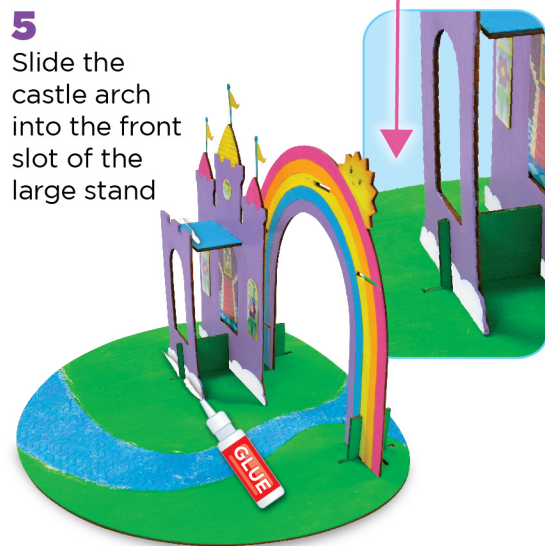
3 Slide the castle into the slot of the large stand in front of the rainbow



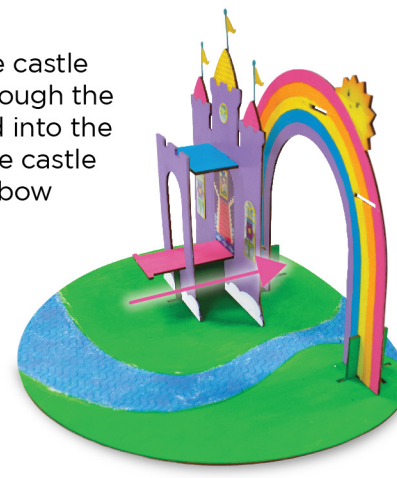
4 Slide the castle balcony into the top slit of the castle and through the rainbow



5 Slide the castle arch into the front slot of the large stand



6 Slide the castle floor through the arch and into the slit of the castle and rainbow

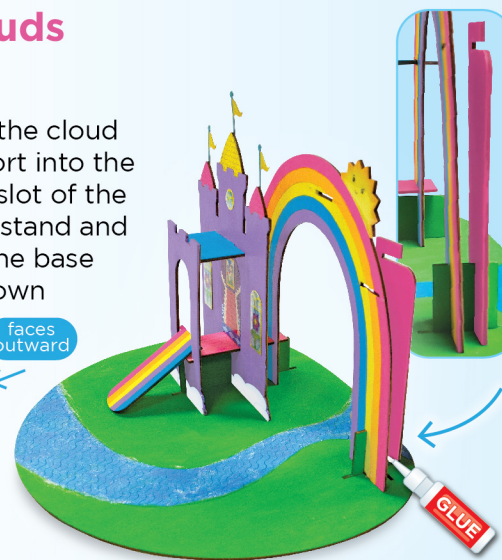


7 Tilt the slide at an angle and insert inside the castle arch. Rest the rounded end of the slide onto the base

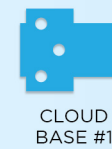


Clouds

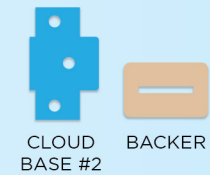
1 Slide the cloud support into the back slot of the small stand and into the base as shown



2 Slide cloud base #1 into the right slit of the rainbow and through the cloud support



3 Slide cloud base #2 into the center slit of the rainbow and glue backer behind rainbow

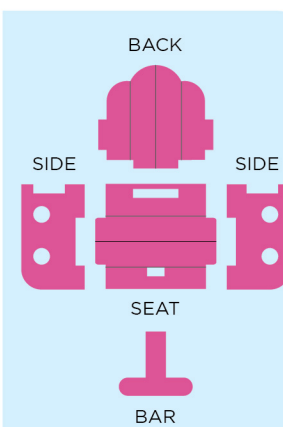


4 Glue cloud #1 and #2 onto the front of the bases

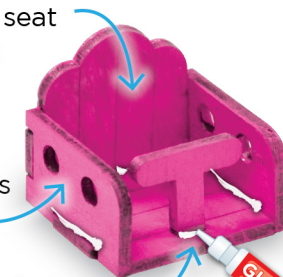


Swing

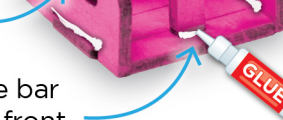
Set the swing seat pieces on your work surface and assemble as shown.



1 Slide the back into the seat opening



2 Attach the sides



3 Slide the bar into the front seat opening



4 Thread the long blue string through the holes on the side of the swing. Knot the ends together as shown. Repeat on the other side



5 Thread each knotted end through an outside hole in cloud base #1. Tie the 2 knots together



6 Pinch the raindrop stickers onto the strings to make it look like it's raining

Ducks and Frog

Attach stickers to both sides of the 2 ducks and frog. Add a small amount of glue and slide them into their bases.
