






PRIOR TO INSTALLATION:

- · Do not install on copper DWV as copper is highly corrosive.



PVC Connecting Tubes

1. Mark Anchor Position

· Mark the center and place the anchor at the recommended distance.


NOTE: It is recommended to use a PVC drainpipe.



2. Drill According to Wall Material Drill the mark with Ø 5/16" drill bit for concrete


- · Drill the mark with \emptyset 5/16" drill bit for concrete (not included).
- For installations with wood framing, sheet rock and tile, you will need to put proper backing behind the wall before installing the product.

 NOTE: 3/4" plywood is a suitable backing for this installation. Preferably a minimum of a foot wide with the bracket centered in the middle of the 3/4" plywood. Make sure to securely fasten backing.



3. Attach Bracket


- · Insert the anchor into the marked hole.
- · Attach the wall bracket using the washer and lag screw.



4. Install Connecting Tubes

- · Insert the trap connector or adapter into the drainpipe, make sure the drainpipe is rigid and fixed to the wall.
- · Insert the tube into the drain, cut tube if necessary.


NOTE: If the drainpipe is a different diameter it is recommended to buy a sanitary coupling or adapter as needed.




5. Check Mount Position

- · Mount urinal on wall bracket.
- · Screw the nut into the cartridge. Verify the tilt of the pipe elbow is adequate to avoid stagnation and bad odors.


NOTE: If the bracket needs to be adjusted, remove urinal, loosen lag screw and adjust bracket up/down as needed.






6. Secure Mount


- · Remove urinal and bracket from the wall.
- · Mark the missing holes in the bracket with a pencil.
- · Drill remaining marks with Ø 5/16" drill bit for concrete (not included).
- · Insert anchors into the marked holes.
- · Attach the wall bracket using the washers and lag screws.




7. Secure Urinal

- · Mount urinal on bracket and reattach to cartridge and piping.
- · Reverify the tilt of the pipe elbow is adequate to avoid stagnation and bad odors.








8. Daily Cleaning

- · Perform daily cleaning with cleaning product of your choice.
- · It is very important to pour at least one gallon of clean or recycled water every day. **NOTE:** Use soft fibers to avoid scratching the ceramic.


9. Monthly Maintenance

· Remove cartridge with provided maintenance key by turning counterclockwise.


NOTE: other household tools can be used to remove the cartridge as a substitute for the maintenance key.




- · Submerge the cartridge in soapy water three (3) to rinse the unit.
- · Carefully disassemble the cartridge by twisting the lower half of the cartridge to remove completely. Then, use a soft brush or rag to scrub the bottom of the cartridge.



· Continue disassembly by twisting the cartridge top and the sphere holder to reveal the large sphere. All three components can be submerged in the soapy water and scrubbed.



· Rinse all parts in clean water before reassembling



10. Troubleshooting

PROBLEM	CAUSE	SOLUTION
Bad Smell	 The cartridge sphere is not sealing. Connector is disassembled or incorrectly installed. The sphere is not inside the cartridge. 	Remove cartridge and wash its components.Insert the connector and check installation.Place sphere into cartridge.
Stagnant Liquids	· Pipe elbow tilt is not adequate for drainage. · Accumulation of sediment in product/pipeline.	 Uninstall and reinstall the product. Remove product, wash components, and pour clog remover/ perform mechanical maintenance on the pipe.
