WINEMAKER SHANE MOORE YAMHILL-CARLTON WILLAMETTE VALLEY Grenache is the warm climate analog to Pinot noir. Lighter in color and tannins, difficult to grow, susceptible to disease, absolutely stunning when grown in the right environment and vinted by craftspeople with a light touch. I knew that if we were to do this The Rocks were the one place that would be compelling enough for us to put our collective efforts 100% into the project. The wine tastes like the rocks and funk of where it's grown and is obviously made with the light hand of a Pinot noir winemaker. It's delicious and compelling and has something to say. The Rocks Grenache is a natural extension of the Flavorscape. A way for me to kind of close a loop that started out by riding in those old 1970's Ford pickups during the summers of my childhood.

VINTAGE The 2023 vintage in Walla Walla experienced mild temperatures and lot's of summer rain. A more challenging year for producing big reds.

AROMAS Strawberries, wet stone, roasted wild boar, navel orange peel, wild Nootka rose, Peony, cranberry, pomegranate.

FLAVORS Tangelo, pink grapefruit, evergreen huckleberry, cornflakes, vanilla, cardamom, gravel road, hint of matcha

TEXTURE Huge uplift in the front palette all the way across and broadly moving to the mid. Sailing downward toward the cleansing finish. Throughout the texture there is certainly broadness and density, yet the mouthfeel remains refreshingly light and airy.. VARIETAL 100% Grenache AGING 17 days on skins, 50% new French oak ALCOHOL 13.6% VINEYARD Hallowed Stones, The Rocks AVA WINEMAKING 30% whole cluster TA 4.80 g/L pH 3.64
