Important Information About the Paint

- The paint included is a specially formulated non-toxic, acrylic paint that dries permanently on most surfaces, so be careful!
- · Cover you work surface with newspaper. Have a cup of water and paper towels handy.
- · Wear a smock or old clothes. This acrylic paint can stain. Clean up any spills immediately with soap and water.
- Paint can settle and separate over time. Mix each color thoroughly before you begin painting. If the paint seems too thick, stir in a drop or two of water.
- Before changing colors, rinse and dry your brush thoroughly.
- Paint your race car a solid color or try creating a pattern for a style all your own. Take a look at the stickers before you start to paint so you can add them to your design.
- After painting your cars, wait until the paint dries and then apply the stickers.
- Now it's time to race, just pull back and let'em go!

Helpful Hints and Ideas:

- Use the sandpaper to smooth out any rough edges before you begin painting.
- You can trim your stickers to fit any place on your car for a totally original look.
- Apply the 3-D stickers to make realistic looking windows and headlights.
- Use your creative mind to add animal patterns, stripes, dots, or any other special paint effects.
