Programme objectives

1. Demonstrate a sound knowledge of the historical and cultural context of education in Jamaica and the Caribbean.
2. Demonstrate a sound understanding of the theoretical and practical aspects of curriculum development.
3. Demonstrate a sound understanding of the role of the teacher in curriculum development.
4. Demonstrate a sound understanding of the role of the school in curriculum development.
5. Demonstrate a sound understanding of the role of the community in curriculum development.
6. Demonstrate a sound understanding of the role of the parent in curriculum development.

Course description

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This course provides a foundation for students in the Faculty of Education. It covers the historical and cultural context of education in Jamaica and the Caribbean, as well as the theoretical and practical aspects of curriculum development. The course is designed to provide students with a sound understanding of the role of the teacher, the school, the community, and the parent in curriculum development.
