
Insert Cam Lock Screws into pre-drilled in Top (A), Side Panels (B), (C) and Back Rail (G), then tighten. (See Figure 1)

Attach Left Guide to Side Panel (B) and Right Guide to Side Panel (C) with Varianta Screws.

Attach Left Guide and Right Guide to Divider (I) with Varianta Screws.

Attach Magnets to Rail (E) with Magnet Screws into pre-drilled holes. (See Figure 3)







