

PROBATION

Probation is a court-ordered period of supervision for individuals who have been convicted of a crime. It is often used as an alternative to incarceration for first-time offenders or those with minor offenses. The probation officer monitors the individual's behavior, ensures they comply with court orders, and provides support and resources as needed. Violations of probation can result in a return to prison.
