


Quick Zip Pipe Hanger


For 4 Inch Plumbing

- Locate supply or drain-waste-vent (DWV) pipe that is to be installed.
- 2. Determine the center line of the plumbing. Then adjust for the proper fall as called out for the local building codes.
- 3. Install item "B" on a floor joist, a roof rafter, or other solid structure that is sufficient to support the load. There are multiple holes in item "B" that can be used to install the included nail.
- 4. After completing step 3, item "A" will need to be installed through the lower section of item "B".
- 5. Install the DWV/supply plumbing in part "A" prior to closing part "A".
- 6. Install the strap end of part "A" into the buckle end of part "A".

 Tighten the strap portion as hand tight as possible.*

 If needed, the strap can be loosened by gently lifting up on the tab portion of the buckle.





* The load should not exceed 50 lbs per hanger.
