Care & Maintenance

This furniture is designed for indoor use.

To help protect wood furniture, follow these steps:

Use a humidifier, preferably one with an automatic control system that can sense the humidity level and adjust itself accordingly

Keep furniture out of direct sunlight, which can cause it to dry out, crack and warp

Do not put furniture near heating vents

Dust with soft dry cloth

Do not use liquid or aerosol products

Do not use abrasive cleaners

To help protect leather furniture, follow these steps:

Wipe regularly with a clean damp, soft cloth.

Do not place in direct sunlight as it may fade.

Do not apply heat to full-grain leather if it gets wet because it could lead to cracking.

Always let full-grain leather air dry at room temperature.

To prevent over-drying, apply leather conditioner every 3 to 6 months.

Professional cleaning advised for more persistent stains.

Do not use any cleaners with corrosive ingredients (lye, acids or ammonia).
