to paint, decorate and hide 10 glow-in-the-dark rocks!

GETTING STARTED

Please rinse and thoroughly dry
the rocks before you begin painting.

Formed by nature, each rock has
its own unique shape and size.
Little rocks can become bugs or
small flowers, bumpy rocks can be
swiss cheese, broken rocks can be a
cookie with a bite taken out of it.
Look at your rocks and let the shape inspire your creativity!

Cover your work surface. Have a cup of water and
paper towels handy.

Wear a smock or old clothes. This paint may stain fabrics,
furniture and other surfaces. Clean up any spills immediately
while the paint is still wet.

The acrylic paint pots can settle and separate over time.
Mix each color thoroughly before you begin painting.

Before changing colors, rinse and dry your brush thoroughly.

Before using the glow-in-the-dark paint tubes, be sure the
acrylic paint is completely dry.



ACRYLIC PAINT

For ideas or inspiration, refer to the samples on the box and in the instructions.

Use the acrylic paint pots as your base coat. To deepen the colors, you may need more than one coat of paint. For better coverage or to make your paint brighter, start with a coat of white paint first.

Allow the paint to dry between coats.

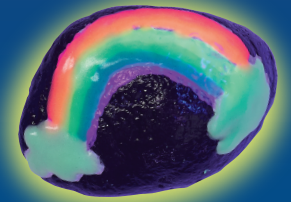
Pro tip - to make your rocks more weather-resistant, paint the bottom of your rocks too.



SHOW US YOUR ROCKS

Part of the fun of this kit is sharing with others. Place a clear tracking sticker on the bottom of your rocks. That way you and the finder can post pictures on our Facebook and Instagram with the hashtag #creativityforkids

Share your creativity with rock painters and finders everywhere! Remember, always seek adult permission and assistance before visiting any social media sites.



LET IT GLOW!

Use the glow paint tubes to make dimensional, glowing accents. Practice squeezing the paint tubes onto a paper towel first. Use the paint nozzle to make fine dots or designs.

When the paint has dried, place your rocks under a bright light or a black light.

Turn off the lights and watch them **GLOW!**

HIDE YOUR ROCKS

Ask an adult for permission and assistance.

Now place your rocks where people will find them. While you are out hiding rocks, make sure you keep your eyes open, as you just may find a few rocks of your own.

Although the paint included in your set is weather-resistant, natural weathering or fading of your painted rocks may happen over time. Save any leftover paint to paint new rocks.

Note : the paint will continue to harden over time.

For best results, do not allow your decorated rocks to touch and do not place them in a plastic bag or they may stick.
