Jackson Estate wines showcase our cherished vineyard estate properties located on rare, coastal California terroir of mountain tops, ridges, hillsides and raised benchland soils. This limited release allows our wine makers to emphasize the extraordinary terroir of our unique properties and craft very small lots for refined palates.

ALEXANDER VALLEY

Established in 1984, the Alexander Valley AVA is a long, slim wine growing region defined by the Russian River winding up its midline and the Mayaca mas Mountains lining its eastern borders. The portion of the AVA we farm for this wine is comprised mainly of mountains, ridges, hillsides, and benchlands, and is filled with a diverse array of soils rich in ccium, gravel, sand and clay.

KEY POINTS

Elevation: 1,200 - 2,400 feet

Soil: Steep hillside, slightly terraced. Shallow rock with gravelly loam.

Climate: Mountain vineyards above the fog level allow cooler mornings and warmer nights. *Profile:* Bright red fruit with a fleshy mid-palate. Balanced with structured, elegant tannins.
