Your set Includes 5 colors of washable tempera paint, 5 texture tools, mixing bowl, 20 sheets of paper and reusable storage bag.

Important Information about this paint

- The paint included is a specially formulated non-toxic tempera paint.
- Cover the surface you are working on with newspaper. Have a cup of water and paper towels handy.
- Wear a smock or old clothes. Although the paint is washable from most surfaces, as with all art supplies, it may stain some fabrics or furniture. Clean up any spills immediately following the manufactures recommendations.
- Be sure to wash your texture brushes with soap and cold water after using them.

Mixing Colors

You can use the paints directly from the bottle, or try mixing them to create new colors.

Red, Blue and Yellow are called Primary Colors. When combined, these colors can be used to make Orange, Green and Purple – the secondary colors.

Use this mixing chart and your bowl to create new colors. You may want to add a drop or two of water to make your paint go further.

Mix equal parts of the paint as shown below. You can adjust the amounts as needed to get just the color you want.



Black and White are called neutral colors. To make a color lighter add white. For example, to make pink combine white paint with a few drops of red.



To make a darker color, mix in a little black paint. For example, to make Maroon add a few drops of black paint to the red.



Painting with the Texture Brushes

Select a paint color and place it in your bowl. Remember, always clean your bowl and brushes before changing colors.

Each texture brush will give you a different pattern and effect. Try combining different textures and colors.

Look at the patterns and tools below. You can change the patterns and effects by pulling, twisting, swirling, dragging, or by changing the angle. Try stamping with your brush straight up and down to create a continuous pattern.
