Jackson Estate wines showcase our cherished vineyard estate properties located on rare, coastal California terroir of mountain tops, ridges, hillsides and raised benchland soils. This limited release allows our winemakers to emphasize the extraordinary terroir of our unique properties and craft very small lots for refined palates.

PANORAMA VINEYARD

Our estate Panorama Vineyard sits in the heart of the Arroyo Seco AVA in Monterey County. Daily wind and cooling fog, make this one of the coldest wine regions in California, leading to a long growing season and extended hang time for the grapes. This maritime climate combined with well-drained loam and alluvial gravel soils produces Pinot Noir grapes with concentrated, bright, vibrant fruit flavors.

KEY POINTS

Elevation: 400 - 600 feet

Soil: Well-drained Arroyo Seco gravelly loam, formed from granite and alluvial fan.

Climate: Cool climate with afternoon winds. Fog is usually thick in the evenings, coming in daily from the Monterey Bay.

Profile: This Rosé sparkles with light and life, providing a minerally tight profile with aromas of stone fruit and faint hints of orange blossom. Flavors of warm citrus and apricot bring forth a controlled crispness and elegance with a bright and silky finish.
