

RACE TRACK

Enjoy hours of imaginative play! Scoop, sort and explore the treasures inside your sensory bin.

CARE AND SAFETY

- Children should be supervised during play not suitable for children under 3.
- Prepare the area under the bin with a towel or table cover to collect any spills.
- To keep the sensory bin clean, wash hands before use.
- Keep Sensory Sand and gravel away from the eyes, nose and mouth.
- Water and humidity will change the consistency of your Sensory Sand. It can be air dried
 as needed to return it to its original texture.
- · Keep the sensory bin closed when not in use.

⚠ WARNING:

CHOKING HAZARD - Small parts. Not for Children under 3 vears.

Assemble

Start by helping your child decorate the bin sides with the colorful clings. It is best to add these before you add the Sensory Sand. **Note:** If you are having a hard time rearranging the clings later, wipe down the clings and bin sides with a damp cloth to remove sand residue.

Next, have an adult empty the bag of Sensory Sand into the bottom of the bin. Spread sand out evenly, then clear a path for where you want your race track to go. Fill the path with the gravel, then arrange all other items in the bin. Eventually the Sensory Sand and gravel will combine; you can still create new tracks by using your rake to make a path.



Play!

Race, rake and play while engaging your senses. Have fun creating the layout of your race course and speeding around the track with your two speedy race cars.

Note to Parents - Using the rake, clings and race cars are a fun way for your child to practice their fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination.





Fun things to try:

- · Count the items inside the bin.
- Name each item in the bin.
- Make up a story about your race cars and who will win the Gold Cup Trophy.
- · Call out the colors of each item.

- Memory game: Parents Remove an item from the bin. Have your child guess what is missing.
- Close your eyes and grab an item from the bin. See if you can identify it using your sense of touch.
- Imagine you are at a race track; What sounds do you hear? Now use your nose; What can you smell?
