



Work with clean hands on a clean work surface. Eric Carle, the author of The Very Hungry Caterpillar, created his famous illustrations by layering different colors and shapes. Use the stickers and suncatcher shapes to create your own Eric Carle inspired artwork.

CHOOSE YOUR SUNCATCHER DESIGN, THEN START LAYERING THE TRANSLUCENT STICKERS AS SHOWN.

PEEL

While your child crafts, encourage them to identify the different shapes and colors.

STICK



Keep stickers inside suncatcher edges.

DECORATE WITH PUFFY STICKERS

Use the puffy stickers to decorate your suncatchers as shown. The caterpillar stickers can be placed on his favorite foods.



Make sure the window is clean. Wet the back of the suction cup to help hold it in place, then hang your suncatchers.




CREATE A PLAYSCAPE

Use the window clings to create a playscape for your suncatchers.

For best results clean your window with a damp paper towel. While the window is still damp, arrange your clings and press them into place.
