

2021 AGRINA VINEYARD PINOT NOIR

VINEYARD

Agrina Vineyard, located in the McMinnville sub-AVA, is one of the most distinct vineyards in our portfolio. The name, Agrina, loosely translates to ‘full of love’ – the winemaker’s love of the fruit, our vineyard manager’s love for the vines, and the love you will feel for this wine at first taste. Lynn and Ron Penner-Ash helped map out the southeast-facing slope of the vineyard and assisted with the clonal selection. The site is planted to a variety of Dijon clones, Pommard, and Wädenswil. This diverse planting produces wines that are dark, dense, and texturally sweet.

2019 VINTAGE

The 2021 growing season began with a winter ice storm, followed by rain at bloom and a heat dome in June. Overall yields were decreased due to the rain at bloom, but flavor intensity remained strong. A warm growing season kept berries small and concentrated. Much needed rains in early September extended the growing season, allowing the grapes a little extra hang time to build up flavor and balance acidity.

TASTING NOTES

Chocolate-covered strawberries mix with vanilla and oak. Initial sweetness transitions to savory cola, creating mid-palate structure and a long, lasting finish.
