Directions for Use

Apply with foam gun. Dilute one part SHOWER FOAM to 20 parts cold water (greater chemical action can be obtained with warm water). Foam onto surface; repeat immediately; permit to react with film and mineral deposits 2-3 minutes; rinse well with water. For extremely heavy soil buildup, foam surface and allow foam to react, then scrub with mild abrasive pad or brush and rinse. Always rinse thoroughly after using. SHOWER FOAM can also be applied with soft bristle brush at a dilution of 1:20 (6 oz./gal.). For heavier soil buildup, dilute at 1:12 (10 oz./gal.). Allow to penetrate and loosen soil; rinse thoroughly. NOTICE: Do not use with ammonia or bleaches. Do not apply with trigger sprayer. Do not use on marble, terrazzo, resilient flooring, aluminum or galvanized metal.
