Assembly tips for your All-Star

- 1 • In order to easily and successfully assemble your new ALL-Star grill, you will need a medium-sized screwdriver and a suitable wrench.
- 2 • Check that you have received all the individual components in your delivery and clearly lay out all the parts.
- 3 • Keep smaller pieces (screws, nuts, etc.) separate so that they do not go missing during assembly.
- 4 • Follow the assembly instructions in the order provided. For additional assistance, you can also use our interactive assembly instructions which guide you through the assembly process step-by-step at www.charbroil.de/all-star-120-b-gas-de-140882
- 5 • Assemble all of the connecting pieces (screws, nuts, etc.) as shown in the pictures in the assembly instructions. Screw them in loosely to begin with and tighten once all of the parts are sitting properly.
- 6 • In order to correctly assemble the legs to the firebowl, turn the firebowl over and loosely screw in the legs. Now, place the unit upside down on an even surface and tighten the screws to ensure that the grill is flat.
- 7 • It is important to assemble the rear panel (part 8) correctly to ensure that the lid opens and closes properly. Insert the piece and then start by fully attaching the central screw. Then, tighten the side nuts. Attach them so that the piece sits well.
- 8 • In order to assemble the lid properly, place it on top of the grill in a closed position. Gently turn the lid hinge pin on one side. Now adjust the lid so that it sits evenly, closes well and attach the second pin.
- 9 • The cooking grate is made from high-quality cast iron and is therefore heavy. Be careful when placing the cooking grate with the TRU-Infrared emitter in the firebowl during assembly or after cleaning and reinstalling. **DO NOT** drop the cooking grate into the firebowl to avoid possible damage to the cooking system. Use the grate cleaning tool provided to remove the grate from the firebowl more easily.
- 10 • **WARNING:** Some parts of the grill may get very hot during use, particularly parts which are close to the gas unit. Never leave the grill unattended. Ensure that children or animals do not come into contact with the grill while it is in use. It is recommended to wear grill gloves as an additional protection measure.
