### SAFETY

- Do not place the heater near a bed because objects such as pillows or blankets can fall off the bed and be ignited by the heater.
- · Always unplug the heater when not in use.
- Always plug heater directly into a wall outlet/receptacle. Never use with an extension cord or relocatable power tap (outlet/power strip).
- Do not operate heater with a damaged cord or plug or after the heater malfunctions, has been dropped or damaged in any manner. Discard heater or return to an authorized service facility for examination and/or repair.
- Do not run cord under carpeting. Do not cover cord with throw rugs, runners or similar coverings.
   Do not route cord under furniture or appliances. Arrange cord away from traffic area and where it will not be tripped over.
- · Check your heater cord and plug connections.
  - a) Faulty wall outlet connections or loose plugs can cause the outlet or plug to overheat. Be sure the plug fits tight in the outlet.
  - b) Heaters draw more current than small appliances, overheating of the outlet may occur even if it has not occurred with the use of other appliances.
  - c) During use check frequently to determine if your plug outlet or faceplate is HOT!
  - d) If so, discontinue use of the heater and have a qualified electrician check and/or replace the faulty outlet(s).
- · Always plug heaters directly into a wall outlet receptacle. Do not use an extension cord.
- · Do not use outdoors.

## **OPERATION**

- 1. Carefully remove your heater from the box. Please save the carton for off-season storage.
- 2. Make sure the unit is in the OFF (O) position before plugging the heater into the outlet.
- 3. Plug the 6-foot power cord directly into an outlet. Do not use an extension cord.

CAUTION: Avoid overloading your circuit by not using other high wattage appliances in the same outlet.

- Place the heater, with its rubber feet facing down, on a firm, level surface.
- 5. Push the power switch to the (I) position to turn the unit ON.
- 6. The switch will illuminate to show the heater is running.

**NOTE:** The heater is single speed and will run continuously at 250 W / 850 BTUs until it is turned off.

**CAUTION:** Front grill is HOT when unit is in operation.

## **Built-in Auto safety shut-off**

This heater is equipped with a total safety system with tip-over and overheating protection that will automatically shut-off the heater in the event of certain unsafe operating conditions.

#### Tip-over shut-off

When the unit is accidentally knocked over, it will automatically shut -off.

Solution: Simply place the heater in an upright position on a level surface and resume normal operation.

#### Overheat shut-off

When a potentially dangerous temperature is reached, the built-in over heating safety system will automatically shut-off the heater off.

## Solution:

- 1. Turn the power switch OFF.
- 2. Unplug the unit and wait 30 minutes, allowing the heater to cool down.
- 3. Make sure heater is clear of all obstructions
- 4. Plug the unit in and operate normally resume normal operation.

# MAINTENANCE

- · Do not operate the heater without the grill in place.
- Do not use the heater if it has malfunctioned or become damaged in any way.
- · Always unplug the heater before cleaning or storage and allow the heater to cool down.
- Clean the unit with a soft cloth moistened with mild soap and water solution.
- NEVER use abrasive or flammable solvents to clean the unit.
- DO NOT IMMERSE THE HEATER IN WATER.
- After cleaning, be sure to completely dry the unit with a cloth or towel.
- · Store heater unit with cord in a cool, dry location.
- We recommend storing the unit in the original package.

# **TROUBLESHOOTING**

If your heater fails to operate:

- Turn the heater OFF and UNPLUG THE HEATER.
- · Make sure the electrical outlet or circuit breaker is working.
- Verify the heater is sitting securely on a flat surface and engages the tip-over protection switch.
- If the heater is hot warm to the touch, unplug heater, allow it to cool down.
- Check for obstructions. If you find an obstruction turn the heater OFF, and clear obstruction PLEASE DO NOT ATTEMPT TO OPEN OR REPAIR THE HEATER.
