- Accelerate slowly to prevent slide off.

- If the edges are curled after being rolled, simply flip it over to use the other side.
- Do not store in direct sunlight.
- The surface of the Yard Glider is slippery. Use caution when stepping around it.
- The integrated side handles double as anchor points for tie downs.
- Attach the pull cords as close to your machine as possible. When pulling the Yard Glider, the front edge should lift off the ground a little to create extra clearance for potential obstacles.
- Yard Gliders make hauling easy, but you should always follow the towing weight limits of the machine you are using to pull your Yard Glider. Ignoring manufacturer limits could result in damage to your machine. See your operation manual or contact your manufacturer directly for specific towing guidelines.
 - * Attach loops over standard tow hitch.
 - * Included links have a 1/2" opening.
 - * Additional hardware may be required to attach the Yard Glider to your machine.
- Extreme pressure and high friction from pulling heavy loads over rougher terrain like pavement or gravel causes a lot of heat – which can melt a hole in the Yard Glider. The Yard Glider will still function as normally intended.
- Do not reverse when Yard Glider is attached to your machine.
