THREE VISTAS

The Russian River Valley AVA is one of the world's premier wine-growing regions. A unique element of the area is the Pacific Ocean's maritime influence, which moderates the warms days of the growing season allowing grapes to ripen and develop slowly. The unique weather patterns combined with a diversity of well-draining soils make the appellation well suited to produce cool-climate Chardonnay and Pinot Noir.

	long, lush finish.
