INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Please read carefully and save these instructions as you may need them a later date.

CAUTION

WARNING: Risk of Fire. Consult a qualified electrician to ensure correct branch circuit conductor.

Turn off the main power at the circuit breaker before installing the fixture in order to prevent possible shock.

GENERAL

All electrical connections must be in accordance with local and National Electrical Code (N.E.C.) standards. If you are unfamiliar with proper electrical wiring connections obtain the services of a qualified electrician.

Remove the fixture and the mounting package from the box and make sure that no parts are missing by referencing the illustration.

ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION

1. Mount the mounting bracket (1) to the outlet box (3) using two outlet box screws (2). Note: The side of the mounting bracket marked "GND" must face outward. The outlet box is not included.
2. Fasten the ground wires of the luminaire and the outlet box (6 and 7) to the ground screw (8) on the mounting bracket (1). Connect the white fixture wire (13) of the luminaire to the white wire (neutral wire 12) of the power supply circuit. Connect the black fixture wire (11) of the luminaire to the black wire (live wire 10) of the power supply circuit.
3. Cover the connections with the provided wire connectors (9). Place the wires back into the outlet box.
4. Attach the lamp body to the bracket, then securely lock it with the mounting screws (5).
5. Install the light bulb (not included, marked as 4), ensuring that it does not exceed the maximum wattage specified on the luminaire's power label.

6. After securing the backplate assembly against the wall, seal the gap between the wall and the backplate with good - quality waterproof caulk or silicone sealant (not included) and allow it to dry (leave a small space at the bottom to let any condensation or moisture escape).
7. Turn on the power.
