	<p><b>Brachioradialis</b> Origin: Lateral epicondyle of the humerus Insertion: Radial styloid process of the radius</p> <p><b>Brachialis</b> Origin: Coracohumeral ligament and distal humerus Insertion: Ulnar tuberosity of the ulna</p> <p><b>Ulna</b> Part of the forearm, articulating with the humerus and radius.</p> <p><b>Radius</b> Part of the forearm, articulating with the humerus and ulna.</p> <p><b>Metacarpus</b> Bones of the hand, articulating with the phalanges.</p> <p><b>Phalanx</b> Bones of the fingers and thumb.</p> <p><b>Carpus</b> A group of eight small bones in the wrist.</p> <p><b>Pollex</b> The thumb.</p> <p><b>Digiti</b> The fingers.</p> <p><b>Manus</b> The hand.</p>
