


IMPORTANT

STEP 1


Assemble Rack Sides (M), (N), Rack Base (O) and Rack Bar (P).


Note: Spice Rack and Towel Bar are interchangeable and may be installed on either side of the unit.

Attach unit to Side Panel (C) with 2 pcs. of 01.






STEP 3

STEP 6

Attach 2 pcs. of **03** and 2 pcs. of **04** to unit with 16 pcs. of **05**.

Attach **03** at front. (See Figure 4)

Note: Arrow label indicates front of unit.





STEP 7

Attach 2 pcs. of **06** to Front Rail (W) by inserting 4 pcs. of **07** into pre-drilled holes, then tighten. (See Figure 5)



Attach Middle Panel (D) to unit, then flip Locks.

Attach Front Rails (I), (W) to unit, then flip Locks.

Slide Towel Bar (L) into position.

Attach Leaf Supports (U) and (V) to unit with 6 pcs. of 14. (See Figure 6)





Attach Top (A) to unit, then flip Locks.



STEP 10


Attach Drawer Front (T1) and Drawer Back (T2) to Drawer Side (T3) with 4 pcs. of **10**.


Attach Drawer Side (T4) to unit with 4 pcs. of **10**.

Slide Drawer Bottom (T5) into groove.


Attach Drawer Bottom (T5) to unit with 4 pcs. of **11**.

Insert 12 pcs. of **11** into pre-drilled holes in unit, then tighten.









STEP 14

Slide Drawers (T) into position.


