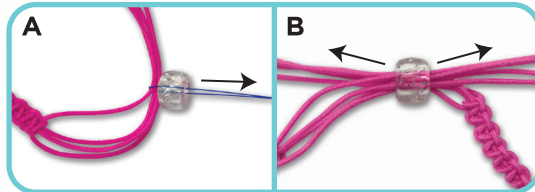


FINISHING YOUR BRACELET

1. Wrap bracelet around wrist. Both ends should touch in the center. If not, create a few more weaves until they touch.



2. Thread all strands from one side through the bead using the needle threader (A). Then, thread all strands from the other side through the opposite side of the bead (B).



3. Pull strands all the way through, so the bead touches the woven part. Tie each group of strands in a tight knot as close to the bead as possible. Trim ends to around 0.5"/1.27cm.

Ask an adult for help if needed.

FRIENDS FOREVER BRACELETS

Make 6 stretchy bracelets to wear and share!

CREATING YOUR BRACELETS

You will need a pair of scissors and a safety pin or tape.

You will weave a short bracelet on each side of the charm, and connect the 2 sides with a bead closure when finished.

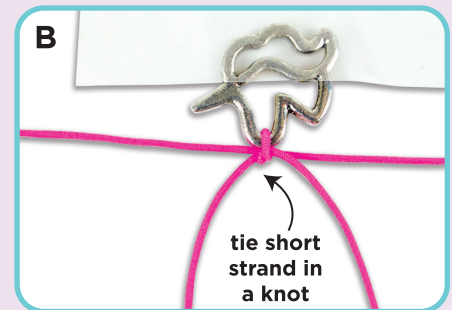
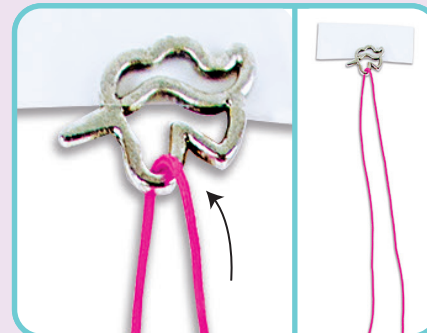
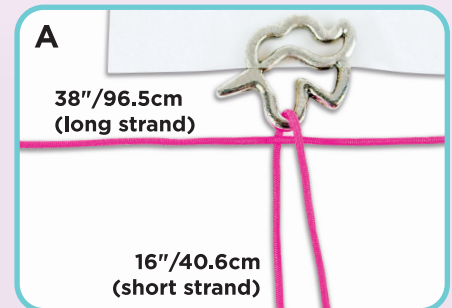


Select a cord color and a charm to go with it. **Note:** 2 rainbow cords are included if you want your "Friends Forever" bracelets to match.

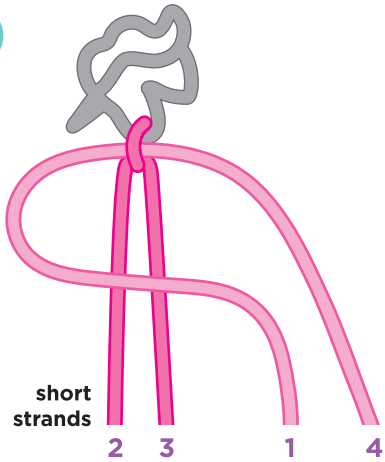
Cut two 16"/40.6cm strands and two 38"/96.5cm strands from one color cord (use the measuring guide inside).

2 Lay the 38"/96.5cm strand between the two tails and close to the charm (image A). Even out the long strand so that the center is by the charm. Tie the short strand ends around the long strand in a knot (image B). Check that all the ends are still even.

1 With adult permission, use a safety pin to pin the charm to your pants near your knee or you can tape your charm to a desk to work. Insert one 16"/40.6cm strand into one side of the charm and even out the ends as shown.



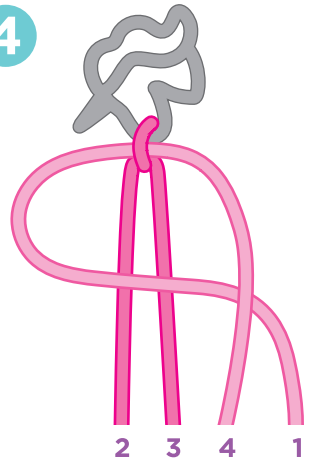

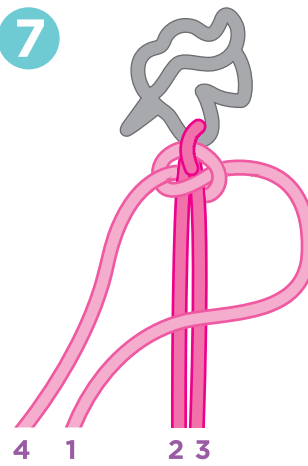
Place the short strands straight down the middle. Cross the left long cord (1) over the two center cords (2 and 3), creating a loop on the left side.

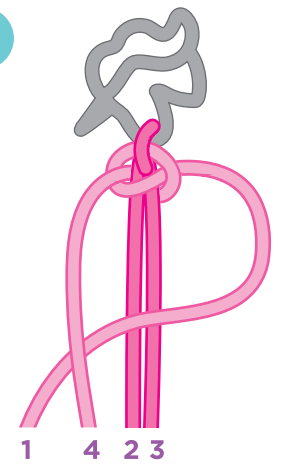
Place the right cord (4) over the left cord (1).

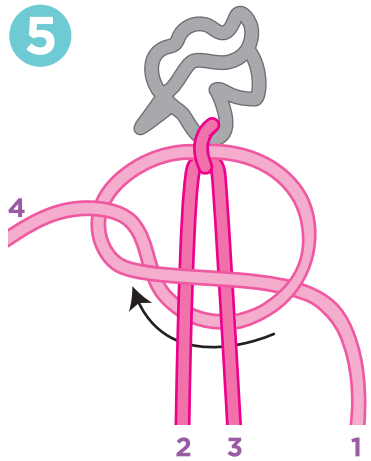
Tie the same knot starting on the right side. Cross the right cord (now 1) over the center cords (2 and 3) creating a loop on the right side.

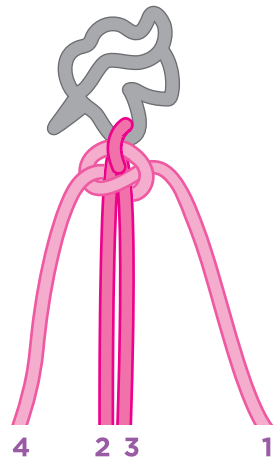
Cross the left cord (now 4) over the right (1).

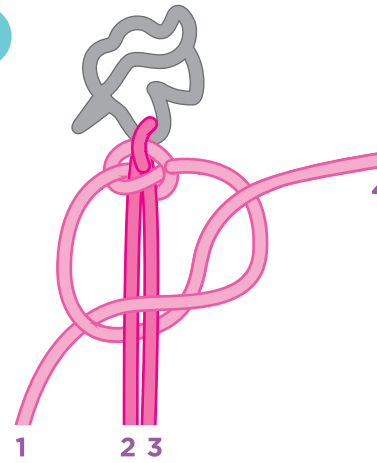
Pass the right cord (4) under the two center cords (2 and 3) and up through the loop you made on the left.

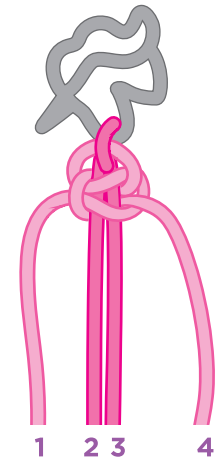
Pull left and right cords (1 and 4) to tighten the knot.

Pass the left cord (4) under the two center cords (2 and 3) and up through the loop you made on the right.

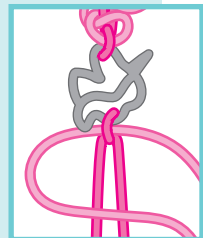

Pull the left and right cords (1 and 4) to tighten the knot.

Follow the steps making sure to switch the side you start on for each knot, until weave reaches halfway around your wrist (about 2.5"/6.35cm). **When 1st side is finished, start with step 1 repeating the same weave on the opposite side of the charm.**
