**QUESTION**  
The diagram shows the internal anatomy of the human eye. Which part of the eye is responsible for focusing light onto the retina?  
A. Cornea  
B. Iris  
C. Lens  
D. Retina

**ANSWER**  
The correct answer is C. The lens is responsible for focusing light onto the retina. The cornea (A) refracts light, but the lens (C) provides the primary focusing power. The iris (B) controls the amount of light entering the eye, and the retina (D) is the light-sensitive layer that receives the focused light.
