

Round Pedestal Dining Table


IMPORTANT NOTE

Carefully remove all the parts from the carton and put them individually on a soft cloth to prevent damage to the parts.







Tool(s) recommended for assembly: Level and Screwdriver




IMPORTANT

- Do not tighten up all the screws until each part is properly assembled.
- You should keep Spanner Wrench in a safe place as you may need to tighten up the Hex Nut in the future.
- Use a soft cloth between these parts and the floor.


STEP 1

Attach the Leg (D) to the Pedestal (C) by inserting Flat Washer, Spring Washer, Hex Nut and tighten using Spanner Wrench. (See Figure 1.)




STEP 2


Carefully turn the Table Top (A) upside down on a soft surface. To keep the Table Top (A) and Extension Leaf (B) stable during transportation, wood slats have been fixed for extra protection. First remove the screws and dispose of wood slats. (See Figure 2.)
Note: We recommend at least two adults assemble this item.



STEP 3


Carefully turn the Table Top (A) upright and loosen the locks, which can be found on the underside. Pull both sides of the Table Top (A) apart and remove the Extension Leaf (B). (See Figure 3.)






STEP 4

Place the open Table Top (A) on the assembled base, fix with Flat Washer, Spring Washer, Hex Nut and tighten using Spanner Wrench. (See Figure 4.)



STEP 5

If required reinsert the Extension Leaf (B), carefully push and close both sides of the Table Top (A) and secure the locks. (See Figure 5.)



STEP 6

Adjust the levelers on the feet until the furniture is level. (See Figure 6.)
