 includes Goldfaber Color PencilsThe pressure you apply to the color pencil determines the intensity of the color application

Shading is ideal for creating beautiful, extensive color gradients, as you apply the colors layer by layer, and are always able to adjust if the gradient isn't quite right.

Hold the pencil in a very flat position so that the entire lead surface is used. This results in a homogeneous color application.

## Directions:

Use the Color Guide and Key to match the color pencil to use for each section.

Start at the top and work down, left to right (right-handed) or right to left (left-handed) so that you won't smudge your illustration with your arm moving across your drawing.

When all the sections are colored in, review your work and add any finishing touches.
