





Outdoor Folding Poly Adirondack Chair

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Do not overtighten screws. (Insert all screws before tightening screws.)


- Please do not exceed the weight limitations of this item.
- Do not stand on or use any part of this item as a step ladder.
- Firmly secure all bolts, screws and nuts before use.
- Reconfirm that all bolts, screws, and nuts are secure every 90 days.
- Do not use or store this item in the proximity of open flame or flammable/combustible chemicals.
- Be aware that some parts are heavy and have sharp edges.
- Be very careful when folding chair to avoid smashing your hands or fingers.





PRODUCT ASSEMBLY - OVERALL VIEW


Look at following overall view of this chair and learn the exact position of each part to be assembled.






Attach Part C Left Chair Leg to Part E Left Chair Arm with 1 pc of Hardware #2 Bolt and Hardware #7 Washer and Hardware #6 Nut. Do same to Part B Right Chair Leg and Part D Right Chair Arm. Attach the locking pin to the chair legs with a screw driver before assembly.

Do not tighten screws too much at this stage.






Attach **Part B Right Chair Leg** and **Part C Left Chair Leg** to **Part A Chair Seat** with 2 pcs of **Hardware #2 Bolt**, **Hardware #7 Washer** and **Hardware #6 Nut**.






Fix Part F Backrest into Part A Chair Seat and then attach Part F Chair Backrest to Part D Right Chair Arm with 1 pc of Hardware #1 Bolt, Hardware #7 Washer and Hardware #6 Nut.

Do the same to attach Part F Backrest to Part E Left Chair Leg.






Attach **Part I Locking Blocks** to **Part F Chair Backrest** (both sides) with 2 pcs of **Hardware #4 Screw** and attach **Part I Locking Blocks** to **Part A Chair Seat** (both sides) with 2 pcs of **Hardware #3 Bolt**, **Hardware #7 Washer** and **Hardware #6 Nut**.






Attach Part G Back Rail to Part A Chair Seat with 2 pcs of Hardware #3 Bolt.


Attach **Part H Front Rail** to **Part B Left Chair Leg** and **Part C Right Chair Leg** with 4 pcs of **Hardware #5 Bolt**.



Congratulations! You finished the assembly of this chair. Pull the locking pin out of both legs to fold this chair as below.


Outdoor Poly Adirondack Side Table

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Do not overtighten screws or bolts. (Insert all screws before tightening screws.)

- Please do not exceed the weight limitations of this item.
- Do not stand on or use any part of this item as a step ladder.
- Firmly secure all bolts, screws and nuts before use.
- Reconfirm that all bolts, screws, and nuts are secure every 90 days.
- Do not use or store this item in the proximity of open flame or flammable/combustible chemicals.
- Avoid using strong power tools to prevent cracking the PE boards when assembling.









Attach **Part B Table Leg** to **Part A Table Top** with 2 pcs of **Hardware #1 Bolt** using an **Allen Wrench**.

Do not tighten the bolts too much at this stage.






Attach **Part C Table Wooden Braces** to **Part B Chair Legs** with 2 pcs of **Hardware #1 Bolt**.






Attach **Part B Table Leg** to **Part A Table Top** and **Part C Wooden Brace** with 2 pcs of **Hardware #1 Bolt** using an **Allen Wrench**.

Tighten all bolts and screws to finish the assembly.





CLEANING TIPS

REGULAR CLEAN: Use a mixture of warm water and mild soap. Gently scrub the surface with a soft bristle brush to remove any dirt or stains.

QUICK CLEAN: You can simply wipe down the furniture with a damp cloth.
