Structure	Function
Cornea	Refracts light entering the eye.
Iris	Controls the amount of light entering the eye.
Pupil	Opening through which light passes.
Lens	Refracts light to focus it on the retina.
Ciliary muscles	Contract to change the shape of the lens for accommodation.
Vitreous body	Maintains the shape of the eye and provides nutrients.
Retina	Receives light and converts it into neural signals.
Optic nerve	Transmits visual information to the brain.
