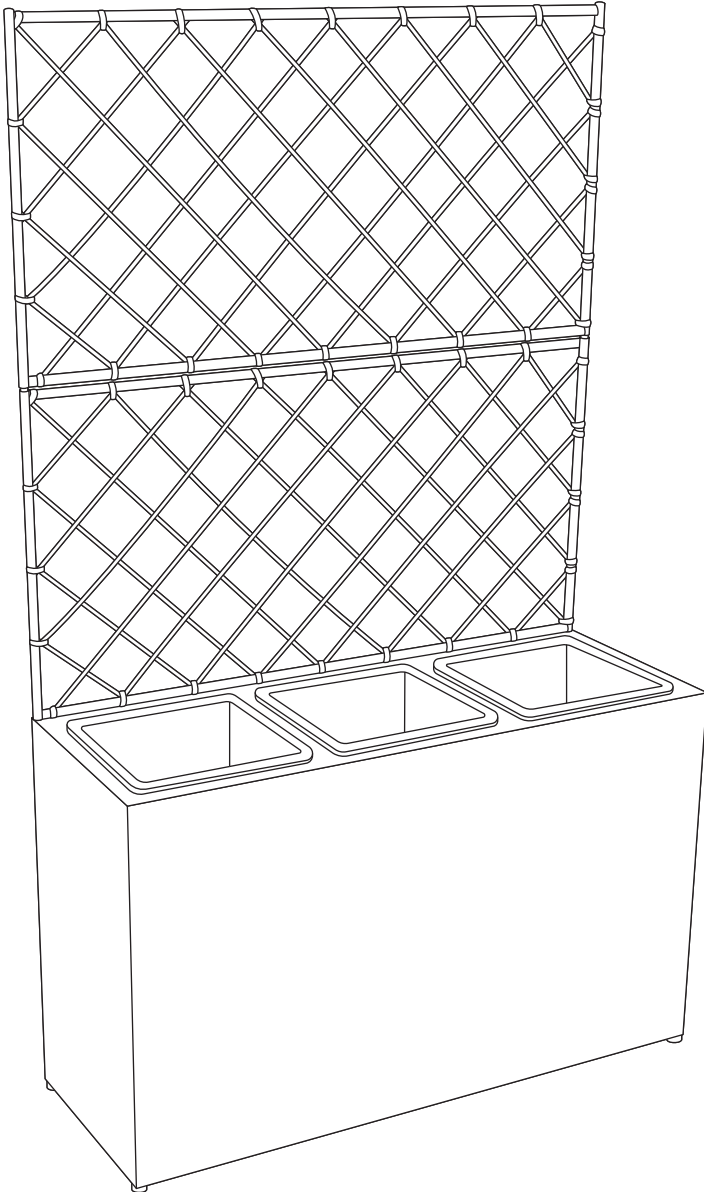


3-SECTION PLANTER BOX WITH TRELLIS





Inspect packaging to ensure all parts are accounted for before disposing of packing materials.

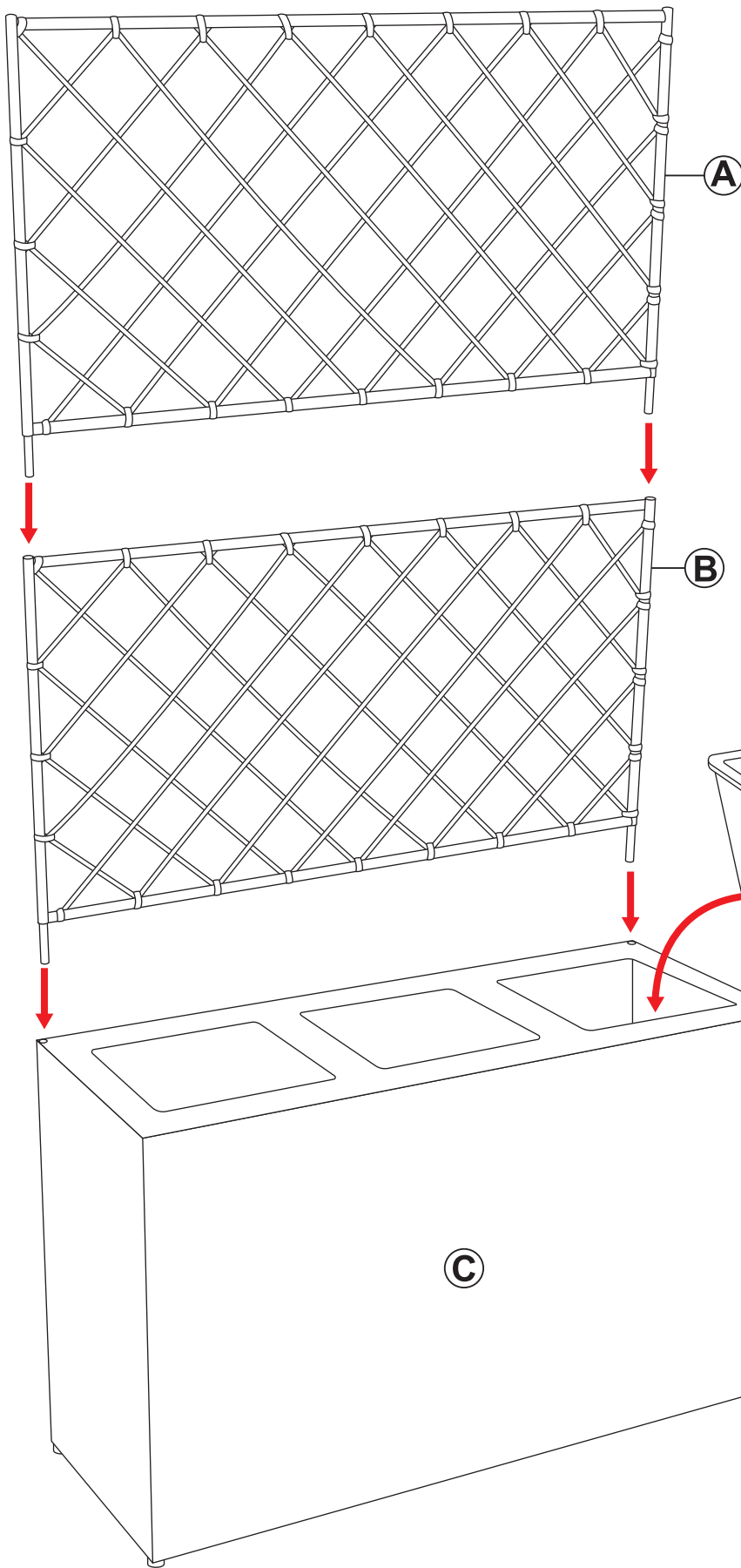

ASSEMBLY



1. Insert Trellis Bottom (B) into Planter Box (C).
2. Insert Trellis Top (A) into the trellis bottom.
3. Install three Liners (D) into the planter box.

IMPORTANT: Only use the planter box on a flat, level surface. Ensure it is level before filling the liners.

To compensate for slightly uneven surfaces, adjust the leveling feet on the bottom of the planter box. Simply loosen or tighten the threaded feet. If the planter box is still uneven, consider selecting an alternate location.

Care & Maintenance

LOCATION: For indoor & outdoor use. Select the desired location before filling the liners.

Be mindful when placing outdoors, the plastic liners do not have drainage holes; soil could quickly become waterlogged during heavy rain. Leaks and/or run-off from planters could cause damage to surfaces.

FILLING & WATERING: Lightweight potting soil is recommended for filling the liners. Take care when watering. The plastic liners do not have drainage holes. If using the planter outdoors, ensure it is in a location that will not receive too much rain, such as a covered porch or under an awning.

CLEANING:

Polyrattan: Brush, vacuum or use a garden hose to remove loose dirt and debris. If using a hose with a spray nozzle, use gentle or medium pressure settings; high-pressure sprayer settings may damage the construction of the planter and void the product warranty.

Mix 1/4 cup of soap or a mild detergent with 1 gallon of warm water. Using a soft-bristle brush, gently scrub the dirt and grime from the polyrattan.

Thoroughly rinse, ensuring all soap residue has been removed and allow to air dry.

Plastic Liner: Mix 1 part distilled vinegar with 4 or 5 parts warm water. Wash the liner with the mixture and a soft cloth. Rinse thoroughly and dry.

EXPOSURE: Over time, sunlight and weather elements may degrade and change the color of this product.

STORAGE: Store in a dry, indoor location. Cover to prevent dust build-up.

- Only use this unit on a flat, level surface.
- Do not exceed the capacity of the unit.
- Never stand or climb on the unit.
- Never use chemical cleaning products or polishes as doing so may damage the finish.
