III. Application and Directions

Before treating the entire surface we recommend testing a trial patch for colour fastness, in an inconspicuous place. Spray until wet and wipe with a white cloth, if colour comes off consider use.

- 1) Prepare surface by cleaning and drying thoroughly
- 2) Shake well before use
- 3) Hold can upright, approximately 15-20cm away from surface
- 4) Apply evenly in a smooth sweeping motion, until moist. Try to avoid over-saturation.
- 5) For best results apply a second coat once first coat is dry
- 6) For maximum performance, after final coat, allow to dry for 24 hours
- 7) When the item becomes soiled, wash as usual and then reapply Aqua Armour, following the same application process
- 8) DO NOT use on suede or delicate leathers
