The deluxe overbed table has a weight limitation of 25 lbs.

Assembling/Disassembling

Model 6417

NOTE: For this procedure, refer to FIGURE 1 on page 2.

- 1. Place table top on floor with mounting holes facing up.
- 2. Secure the mast to the table top with six mounting screws. Tighten securely.
- 3. Secure the base to the mast with the two bolts and plate. Tighten securely.
- 4. Place the overbed table to the upright position.
- 5. To disassemble, reverse STEPS 1-4.

Model 6418

NOTE: For this procedure, refer to FIGURE 1 on page 2.

- 1. Place the tilt table top on the floor with supporting bracket facing up.
- 2. Secure the mast to the supporting bracket with the bolt and nut. Tighten securely.
- 3. Secure the base to the mast with the two bolts and plate. Tighten securely.
- 4. Place the overbed table to the upright position.
- 5. To disassemble, reverse STEPS 1-4.

Operating the Overbed Table

NOTE: For this procedure, refer to FIGURE 2 on page 3.

Adjusting Table Height

A WARNING

ALWAYS check to ensure latching mechanism/height adjustment lever, located underneath the table top, is properly engaged prior to use.

NOTE: A transport screw is used to secure the table top to the mast in the lowest position during transportation. The transport screw is located on the mast just below the table top.

- 1. Remove the transport screw and save for future use.
- 2. Install mounting screw where transport screw was removed. Securely tighten.
- 3. Squeeze the latching mechanism/height adjustment lever up toward the table top.
- 4. Adjust the table top to the desired height.

NOTE: When performing STEP 4, be careful not to press too hard otherwise the table top will run through multiple latching points before locking in place.

5. Lightly press down on the table top until table top is locked in place. An "audible" click will be heard when latching mechanism secures table top in place.

Adjusting Table Angle

NOTE: Adjusting table angle is available on Model 6418 only.

- 1. Squeeze the angle adjustment lever up toward the table top.
- 2. Tilt the table top to the desired angle.

3. Release angle adjustable lever to lock in place.

Transporting

CAUTION

Before taking the overbed table apart, adjust the table top to the lowest position and replace the transport screw so the mast is locked in place before being packed and shipped otherwise damage may result.

- 1. Adjust table to lowest height position. Refer to <u>Adjusting Table Height</u>.
- 2. Remove mounting screw and install the transport screw to lock mast in place (FIGURE 2).
- 3. Remove the table top from the mast. Refer to <u>Assembling/Disassembling</u> on page 1.

In the event you do not receive satisfactory warranty service, please write directly to Invacare at the address on the back page. Provide dealer's name, address, model number, date of purchase, indicate nature of the defect and, if the product is serialized, indicate the serial number.

Invacare Corporation will issue a return authorization. The defective unit or parts must be returned for warranty inspection using the serial number, when applicable, as identification within thirty days of return authorization date. DO NOT return products to our factory without our prior consent. C.O.D. shipments will be refused; please prepay shipping charges.
